Rules of Interest

Solid Waste Definition LSA #20-23 (OLQ) – Final Rule

IDEM is proposing amendments to 329 IAC 3.1-5 and 329 IAC 3.1-6 to update the identification of solid waste for the purposes of hazardous waste management to be no less stringent than the analogous federal requirements in 40 CFR 260 and 40 CFR 261.

- Hazardous secondary material recycling under the control of the generator
- Hazardous secondary material transferred to a third party – verified recycler exclusion
- Strengthened definition of legitimate recycling

The proposed amendments will address certain provisions of the federal definition of solid waste affected by a vacatur ordered by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit on July 7, 2017, and the subsequent United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) final rule published on May 30, 2018 (83 FR 24664).

State-specific requirements in the draft rule will be removed for presentation to the Environmental Rules Board.

Rules Still Under Development

Legitimate Use LSA #22-13 (OLQ) – [1st Notice of Comment Period](#)

Based on Legitimate Use Statute P.L. 97-2016

- Defined legitimate use [IC 13-11-2-118.4](#)
- Authorized IDEM to write rules [IC 13-19-3-1.3](#)

First Notice published January 26, 2022

Draft Rule will focus on:

- Standards, criteria, and procedures for determination of a legitimate use.
- Proper storage, handling and recordkeeping requirements.
- Circumstances under which the use of a material is not considered to be a legitimate use, such as for speculative accumulation or sham recycling.
- Standards for the denial of a legitimate use request.
- Streamlined processes for common legitimate uses of specific types of waste or material, such as asphalt shingles.
- Financial assurance requirements for legitimate uses that involve storage of waste or material.
- Amendments to the alternative fuel rules in 329 IAC 11.7 to expand the percentage of alternative fuel that is acceptable use and enable the blending of acceptable alternative fuels.

Rules Still Under Development

Use of Coal Combustion Residues (CCR)

- Effective on passage.
- Uses of Coal Combustion Residues were re-instated. IC 13-19-3-3.1.
- Examples:
 - Raw material for manufacturing another product
 - Structural fill when combined with cement, sand, or water to produce a controlled strength fill material
 - Base in road construction
 - Agricultural application, when applied using appropriate agronomic amounts to improve crop or vegetative production
- Still must comply with Federal CCR Rule.

Class B Fire Fighting Foam Collection Project Update

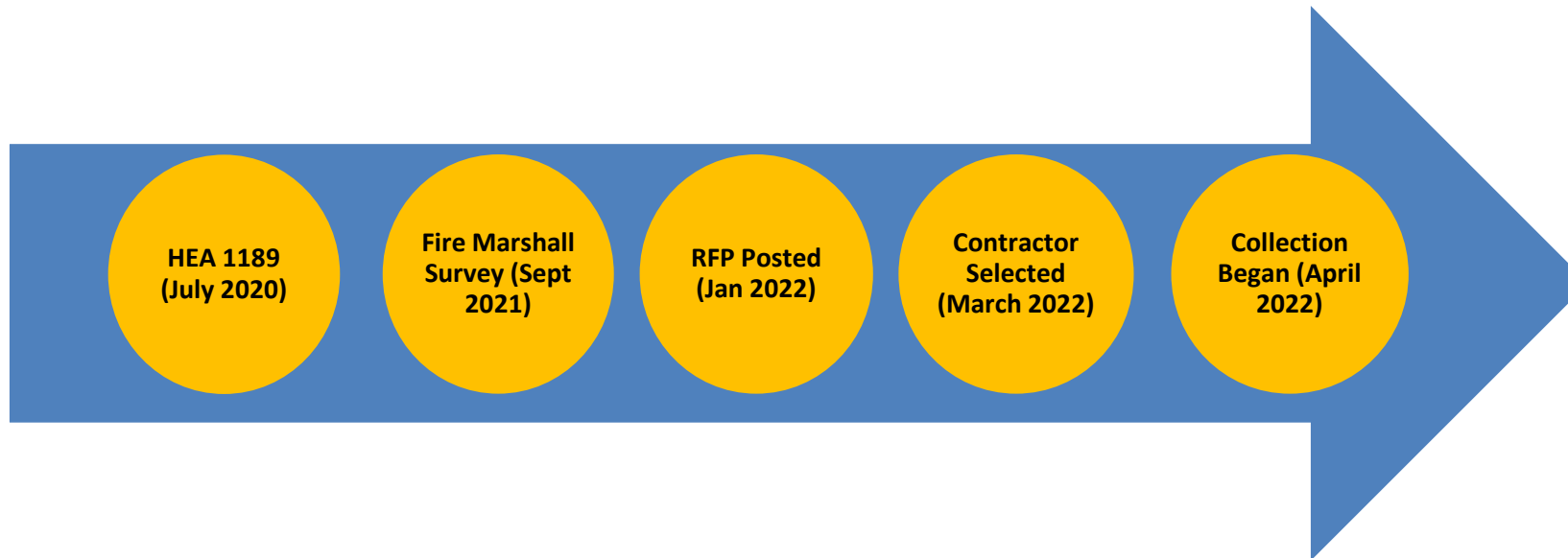


Class B Foam Collection Project

- IDEM has partnered with Department of Homeland Security and the Indiana Fire Marshal on the Foam Collection Program.
- HEA 1189 restricts the use of Class B firefighting foam containing PFAS for purposes of training.
- Limited to municipal and voluntary fire departments across the state.

Indiana Class B Fire Fighting Foam Timeline

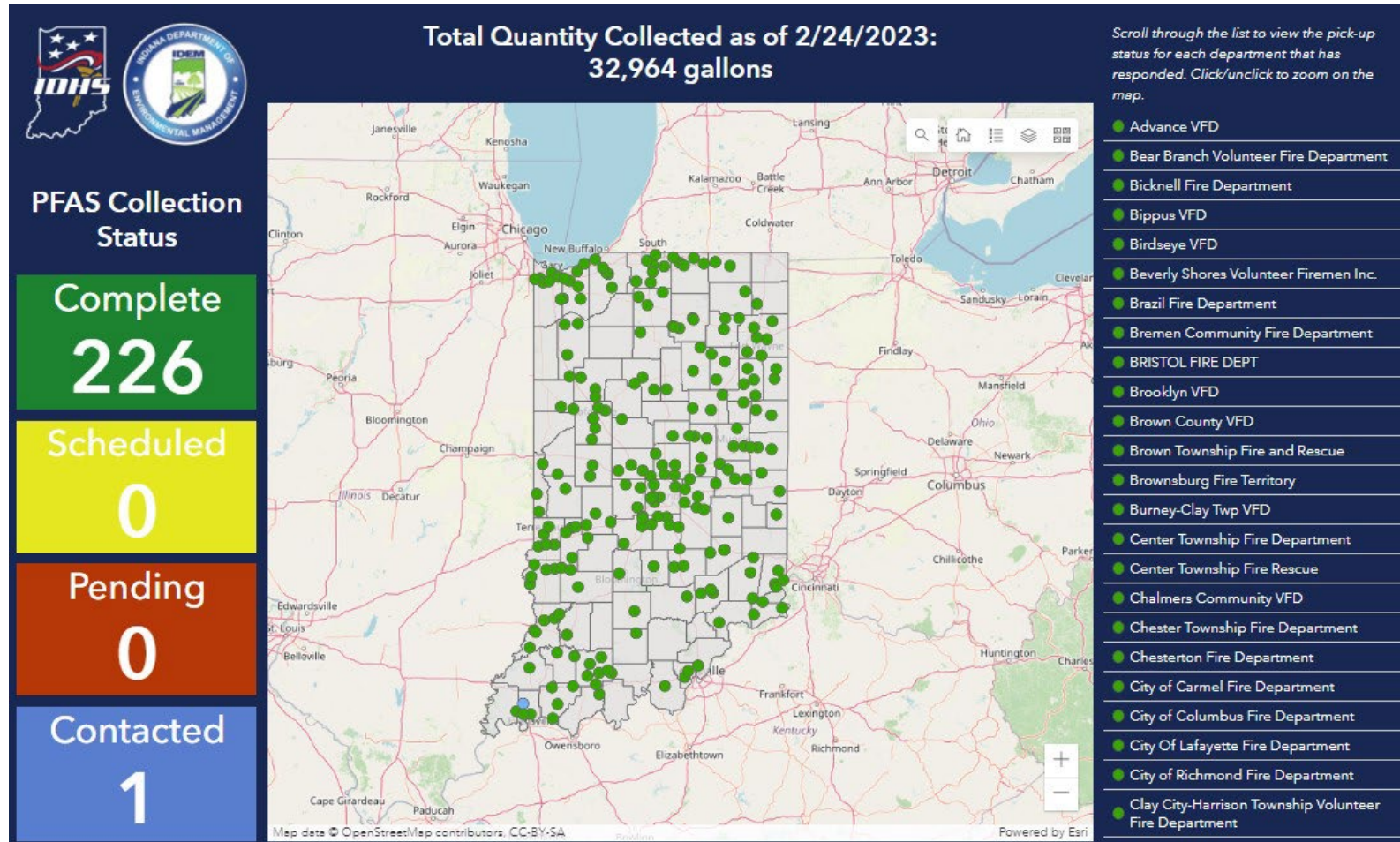

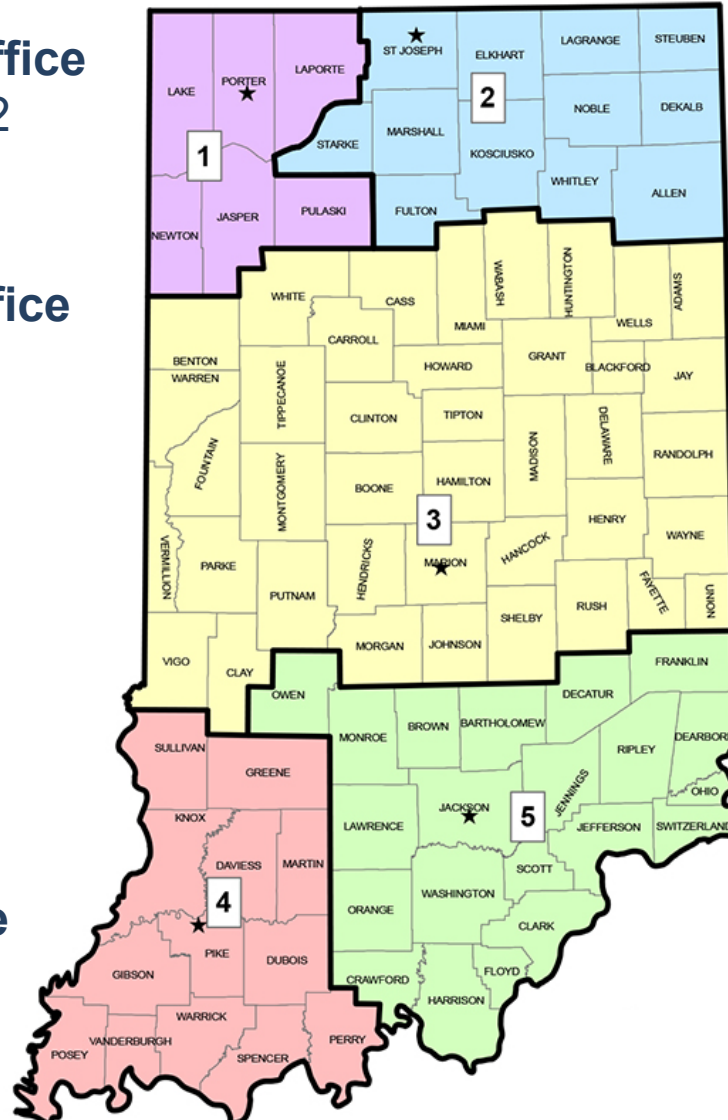

New CTAP Online Portal

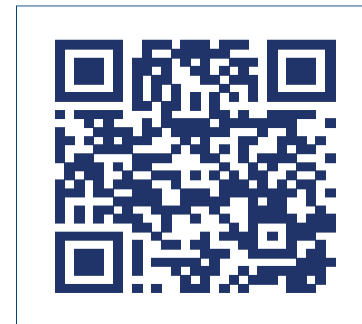
IDEM has launched a new Compliance and Technical Assistance Program online portal through Access Indiana. This new portal is a secure online system that makes it easier for businesses and organizations to request confidential assistance regarding environmental regulations, compliance, and permitting.

In the new CTAP portal, businesses, companies, organizations, and individuals can:

- Create a secure account and submit confidential requests directly.
- Request confidential site assessments for your business or specific equipment/processes.
- Communicate and track interactions with CTAP staff.
- Invite collaborators within the company or designated consultants to access and view the CTAP request and recommendations.
- Provide feedback to the CTAP team through surveys.
