## IV. Adoption of Past Minutes

Chairman Wilson entertained a motion to adopt the minutes from the June 11, 2018 meeting.

The motion was unanimously passed and the Governor's Commission on Minority and Women's Business Enterprises meeting minutes were adopted.

- Troy Phelps presented a Indiana Small Business Development Center (ISBDC) program update
- Christine Jeffers presented a Procurement Technical Assistance Canters (PTAC) program update

### VI. Deputy Commissioner's Report

Maia Siprashvili-Lee, the Deputy Commissioner of Supplier Diversity gave a general overview of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2018:

• Overview of the creation of the Division, M/WBE participation goals and three (3) main functions of the Division: certification, contract compliance, business outreach

- Overview of the Division's organizational chart
- Certification review which highlighted information previously requested by the commissioners
- Compliance review that identified monthly audits, good faith efforts, pre-proposal meetings, state contracts seminar and revision to contract manual
- Business outreach update that addressed having a new business outreach manager, combined outreach meeting and business conference, IEA, DSD grant, 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Division of Supplier Diversity Business Conference
- Payments made to M/WBE subcontractors

### VII. Deputy Director of Certification's Report

Amy Wolf, the Deputy Director of Certification, gave a general review of certification in the 3<sup>rd</sup> guarter 2018:

- Provided comparative numbers for 2018 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter to 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter for new incoming applications (70), recertification applications (75), applications completed (60), preliminary denials issued (6), applications denied (0) and average processing time (33.21 days)
- Reported data for MBE/WBE and total participation for the full years of 2016 and 2017 and year to date data for 2018

### VIII. Deputy Director of Business Development and Compliance's Report

Kesha Rich, the Deputy Director of Business Development and Compliance gave a general review of Compliance and Outreach in the 3rd Quarter 2018:

- Provided a compliance update that reported 5 INDOT Good Faith Effort Reviews were conducted in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter – all 5 were granted; 10 state contracts were audited, 3 with payment and utilization issues and 7 requested subcontractors be replaced on the contract; Supplier Diversity attended 2 pre-proposal meeting and tracked 5 RFP's with MBE/WBE participation
- DSD Business conference update provided a comparison of 2018 business conference dates, location and attendance to 2017 business conference date locations and attendance.
- Reviewed the Division's outreach activities that detailed the 9 outreach events attended, 1 of which was the DSD Northwest Indiana Business Conference in Gary, IN
- Gave an overview of the 8 upcoming outreach events including the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Division of Supplier Diversity Business Conference as well as commission meetings

#### IX. Deputy Commissioner of Procurement's Report

Erin Kellam, Deputy Commissioner of Procurement, gave a general overview of procurement for the 3<sup>rd</sup> guarter 2018:

- Reviewed certified prime spend data and payments made to prime contractors
- Reviewed percentage committed data. Highlighted percentages related to M/WBE contract participation
- Reviewed data by business unit/ department/ agency

## X. INDOT DBE Program Update

Elizabeth Kiefner Crawford, INDOT, Director of Economic Opportunity, presented the Indiana Department of Transportation DBE program update:

- Certification statistics reported 654 certified DBE's and 501 incoming applications
- Reviewed of I-69 progress. Report highlighted a 5% surplus on DBE goal for this project.
- Outreach participation review
- Uniform report highlighted a current 10.9% DBE participation goal
