

Cost Assumptions, Conditions and Constraints

In addition to the Total Bid Price including the cost of goods sold, it also includes labor costs of the staff to produce the menu items and maintain the facility. This RFP does not require a minimum amount of staff per meal. BBNH Enterprises labor cost, however, follows our proposed staffing plan in AttF - Technical Proposal 2.4.2.3. This plan is based on our food service experience and the experience of staffing needed to execute meal service at ILEA.

BBNH understands the food service vendor is responsible for hiring their own employees and establishing wages, benefits.

BBNH Enterprises, Inc. cost of labor does follow all US Department of Labor, Fair Labor Standards Act.

BBNH Enterprises pricing is assuming the training needs and student numbers shall maintain as normal business (excluding COVID shut-downs).

BBNH Enterprises costing and pricing has taken into account very volatile food market conditions and supply chain issues. We have taken into account these conditions in developing this price proposal.
