Samples will be collected from the GES system to comply with the current Kokomo Wastewater Treatment Plant discharge permit, included in the O&M Plan. Parameters, frequency, and analysis methods from Table 1B of the permit, as well as the 2020 USEPA R5 Continental Steel QAPP Addendum 2 (QAPP Addendum 2) Worksheets 18-2, #19 and #30, as well as Figure 2 for locations of GES systems and discharge points will be adhered to. 3b: Annual groundwater sampling assistance for Year 1 only. The sampling will be conducted at all monitoring wells that are screened at shallow, intermediate, and deep depths. Sixty-eight wells will be gauged, of which 50 will be samples for VOCs and water quality parameters.
