• During this calendar year, the Indiana Department of Correction had 2,287 volunteers recorded within the Re-Entry arena.

Highlights

- During this year the Re-Entry department, partnered with the Indiana BMV, issued 3,721 BMV identification cards to the offender population.
- Over 5,500 offenders received a copy of their driving records to assist them in planning for their re-entry.
- The offender population also requested and received 3,352 Indiana birth certificates, 1,512 out-of-state birth certificates, and 5,359 social security replacement cards.
