

## How **ALERT** Works

- 1. Register by visiting http://indianasavin.in.gov or by calling toll free at (866) 891-0330.
- 2. Provide your telephone number(s) and email address(es) for the facilities from which you wish to receive notification.
- 3. ALERT will automatically contact you if an escape or emergency occurs.
- **4.** A follow-up message will be sent notifying you of the offender's re-capture or the resolution of the emergency situation.

## Timely, Accurate & Free Notification

Notifying residents in an emergency used to be a long and tedious process. Officials had to rely on door-to-door contact or the media to get the word out.

When an emergency occurs, officials can access the ALERT Notification Service and notify nearby residents within minutes.

**ESCAPE** In the event of an escape, registrants receive detailed information about the escapee, including physical description and time of escape.

**OTHER EMERGENCIES** Registrants will also be notified of emergency situations in and around correctional facilities.
