# Training = College Credits

- **IDOC is partnering with Ivy Tech to offer college credits for staff completing NETP and MAC.**

Staff completing NETP will receive **7** college credits at no cost to them or IDOC.

Juvenile Staff completing MAC will receive **3** additional college credits for a total of 10 credits at no cost to them or IDOC.

Staff need to provide IVY Tech with their NETP Certificate.



# Training = College Credits

**IDOC staff will receive the discounted state employee tuition rate.**

Staff would need to identify themselves as state employees (recent paystub/ ID) to get the state employee rate (currently at \$111.15 per credit hour).

# Tuition Reimbursement Program

- Employees may receive reimbursement for the following programs per calendar year (January 1 through December 31).
- Master and Doctorate degrees: up to seventy-five per cent (75%) of cost, but shall not exceed fifty-two hundred dollars **(\$5,200.00)**.
- Bachelor degrees: up to seventy-five per cent (75%) of cost, but shall not exceed forty-two hundred dollars **(\$4,200.00)**.



# Tuition Reimbursement Program cont...

- Associate degrees: up to seventy-five percent (75%) of cost, but shall not exceed thirty-two hundred dollars **(\$3,200.00)**.
- Associate degrees obtained at Ivy Tech Community College: up to one hundred percent (100%) of cost, but shall not exceed thirty-two hundred dollars **(\$3,200.00)**.
- Certificates (obtained through an accredited State of Indiana college/university): up to seventy-five percent (75%) of cost, but shall not exceed two thousand dollars **(\$2,000.00)**.



# Requirements for Reimbursement

TRP is offered to active full-time Department employees who meet the following criteria:

- Have been employed with the Department full-time for six (6) continuous months and is a current active employee, and
- Employees who have received a Performance Appraisal, must have met or exceeded overall ratings on the most recent review year.
- Contractors, temps, intermittent, and part-time staff are not eligible.
- The college/university must be an accredited State of Indiana institution
