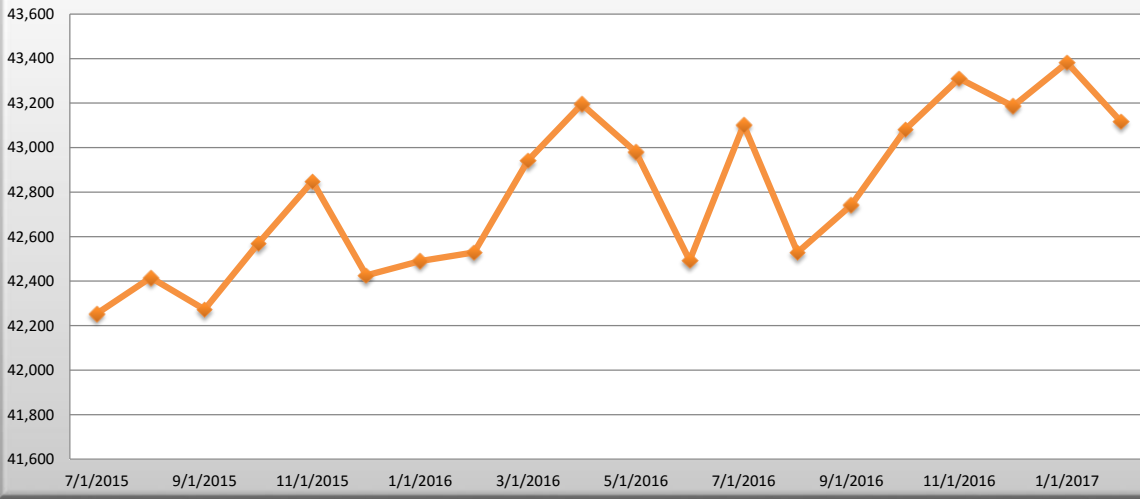

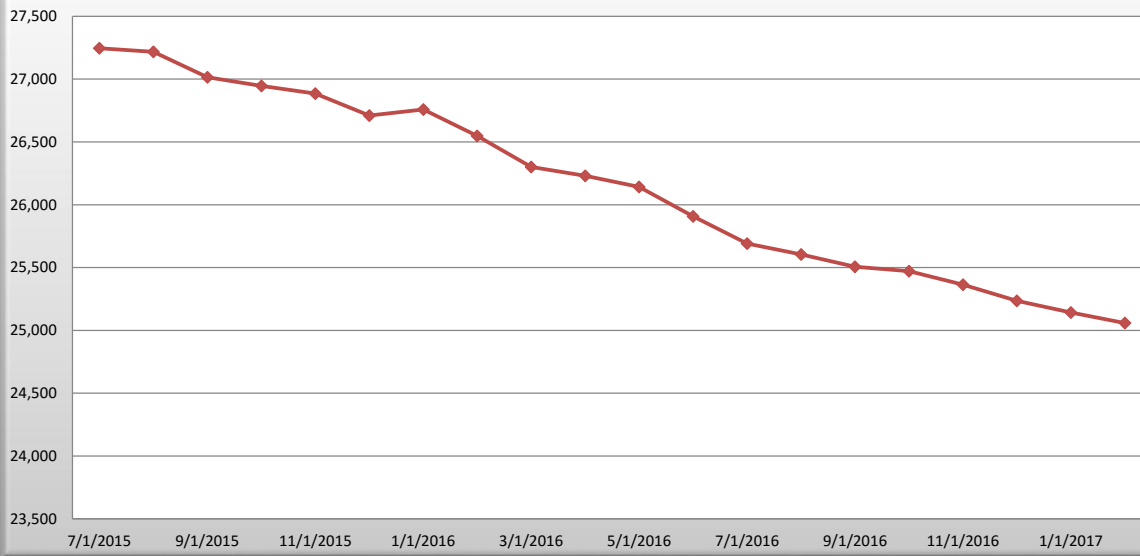

Total Population Trend



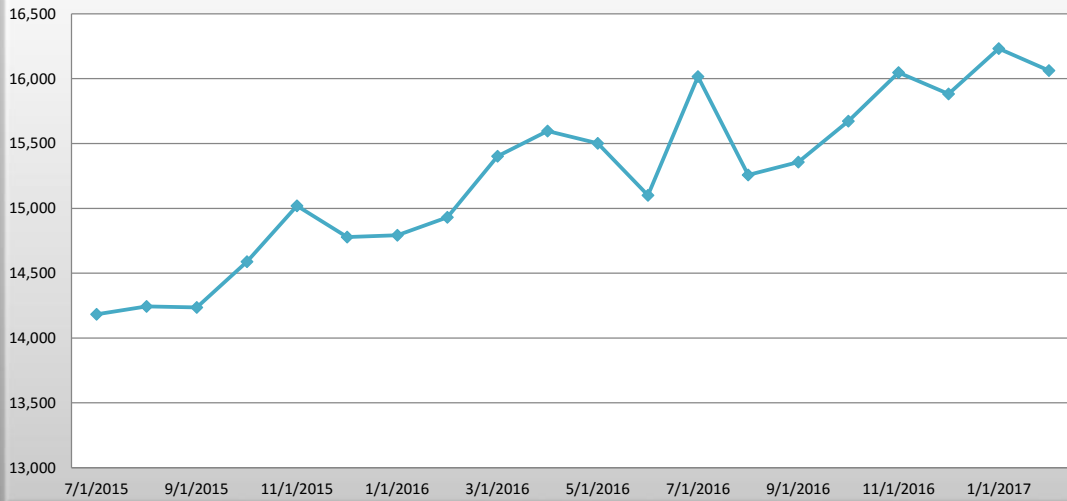

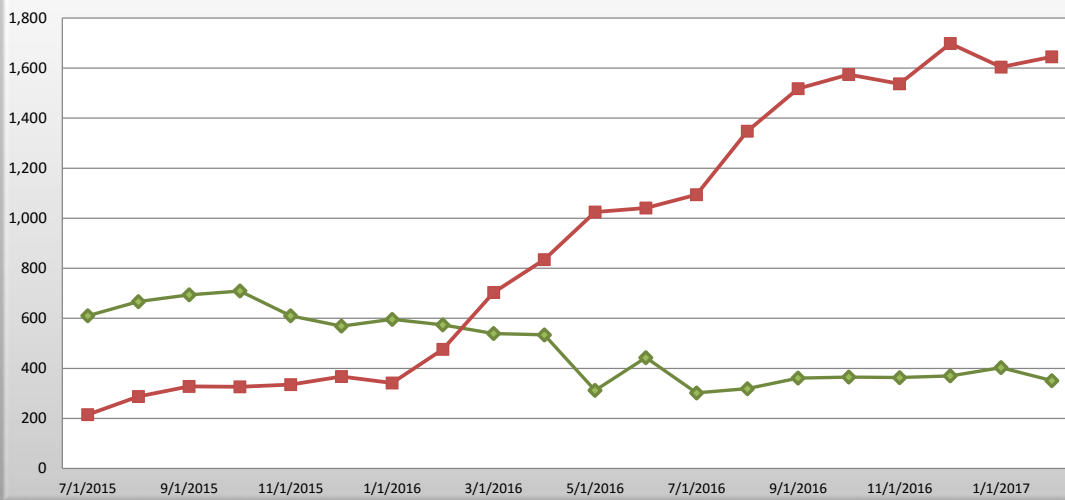
