VA.gov site becomes central login for accessing benefits

Veterans and their families may begin accessing their VA benefits and services on the new and userfriendly <u>VA.gov</u> website starting April 30. Users will be able to access information about VA benefits and services through a single site rather than through multiple locations. All benefits-related features previously located in the eBenefits web portal will be available on VA.gov. Veterans are encouraged to start logging into the site using their current Digital Service (DS) Logon or creating a new account using ID.me.
