

Definitions

For this report, the following definitions apply:

<u>Admission</u> – The means by which an offender enters the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, except for the return of an escapee, this does not include a return from a temporary absence.

<u>Average Daily Population</u> – The sum of the daily beginning counts for a month, divided by that month's number of daily beginning counts.

<u>Beginning Count</u> – The number of offenders physically present at the beginning of the day (ie, 0000:01 hours). <u>Class A Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of thirty years, with not more than twenty years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Class B Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of ten years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than four years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Class C Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of four years, with not more than four years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than two years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Class D Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of one and one-half years, with not more than one and one-half years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than one year subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

<u>Class 1 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 20-40 years, with not more than twenty years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 2 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 10-30 years, with not more than twenty years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 3 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 3-16 years, with not more than twenty years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 4 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 2-12 years, with not more than twenty years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 5 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 1-6 years, with not more than six years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Class 6 Felony</u> – An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned with a sentence range of 0.5-2.5 years, with not more than six years added as a habitual offender enhancement.

<u>Contracted Beds</u> - Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction but are housed in a local work release facility under contract of a 3rd party provider.

<u>County Jail "Back-ups" (Jail Bed Count)</u> – Those offenders who have been committed to the Indiana Department of Correction but are housed in a county jail until they can be transferred to a Department of Correction intake facility. The county receives \$35.00 per day, per offender, to house these offenders.

Ending Count – The number of offenders physically present at the end of the day (i.e., 2400:00 hours).

Felon – A person convicted in any jurisdiction who might have been imprisoned for more than one year.

<u>Murder</u> - An offense whereby a person convicted of this felony shall be imprisoned for a fixed term of fifty-five years, with not more than ten years added for aggravating circumstances, or not more than ten years subtracted for mitigating circumstances.

Definitions Continued

<u>Operational Capacity</u> – The total bed capacity of the facility. The capacity of a facility is the number of beds authorized for safe and efficient operation of the facility.

<u>Pre-Dispositional</u> – An individual ordered by the Court to the Indiana Department of Correction for evaluation prior to sentencing.

<u>Release</u> – The means by which an offender leaves the custody or jurisdiction of the Indiana Department of Correction. For this report, except for an escape, this does not include a temporary absence.

<u>Safekeeper</u> – An individual whom the Court has determined to be in imminent danger of serious bodily injury or death, or who represents a substantial threat to the safety of others, and whom the Court has ordered to the Indiana Department of Correction for custody and security control.

<u>Maximum Level Facilities</u> – Maximum security facilities have very restrictive security measures and housing is celled space.

<u>Medium Level Facilities</u> – Medium security facilities have moderate degree of security measures and housing consists of dormitories and celled space.

<u>Minimum Level Facilities</u> – Minimum Security Facilities have the least restrictive security measures and housing is dormitory style. Also included as minimum security are work release program offenders who leave the facility for outside employment but return nightly.

<u>Intake Facilities</u> – Intake facilities are designated to receive newly committed adult offenders. During the intake process each offender is evaluated through interviews, reports and diagnostic tests. This evaluation forms the basis of the offenders' facility and program assignment.

<u>Secure Housing Units</u> – Denotes maximum control with the most restrictive security measures in place. **Vacancy** – The number of beds available for assignment.

<u>Juvenile Diagnostic/Walkthrough</u> – A Juvenile court can order a youth to the Department of Correction to be temporarily committed for not more than 14 days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and Legal holidays) for the purpose of an evaluation. The youth must be adjudicated delinquent, and the order must be prior to disposition. The department will send a report to the court of the written findings.

Indiana Department of Correction Population Summary

- There were 21,653 adult male offenders (including 712 county jail "back-ups" and 55 in contracted beds) on December 01, 2021. This population is 9% below operational bed capacity for general population.
- ➤ There were 2,165 adult female offenders (including 71 county jail "back-ups" and 40 in contracted beds) on December 01, 2021. This population is 20% below the operational bed capacity.
- ➤ There were 239 juvenile male offenders in the Department's facilities on December 01, 2021. This population is 56% below the operational bed capacity.
- ➤ There were 36 juvenile female offenders in the Department's facilities on December 01, 2021. This population is 40% below the operational bed capacity.
- There were 5,492 adult males on parole in Indiana (4,966 Indiana parolees and 526 other jurisdiction parolees) on December 01, 2021.
- ➤ There were 572 adult females on parole in Indiana (512 Indiana parolees and 60 other jurisdiction parolees) on December 01, 2021.
- ➤ There were 604 adults admitted to IDOC (518 males and 86 females) and 781 adults released from IDOC (699 males and 82 females) in November 2021.
- ➤ There were 25 juveniles admitted to IDOC (22 males and 3 females) and 28 juveniles released from IDOC (23 males and 5 female) in November 2021.



December 01, 2021 N = 2,165






Average Daily Adult Female Offender Populations Calendar Year 2021





Calendar Year 2021






