

RESOLUTION 1995- 46

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING 68 IAC 10-1 TO INCLUDE
A LIST OF APPROVED GAMBLING GAMES**

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. The Commission adopted Article 10, Conduct of Gaming, Rule 10, Rules of Game, General Provisions pursuant to RESOLUTION 1995-29 on October 10, 1995. These rules were published as proposed rules in the *Indiana Register* on November 1, 1995. A public hearing was held on these rules on November 28, 1995, at 9:30 a.m. in Room A of the Conference Center Indiana Government Center South in compliance with IC 4-22. The Commission received a written comment that it would be beneficial to include a list of gambling games approved by the Commission as part of 68 IAC 10-1.
2. IC 4-33-2-9 defines “gambling game” as “any of the following if approved by the Commission as a wagering device:
 - (1) Baccarat.
 - (2) Twenty-one.
 - (3) Poker.
 - (4) Craps.
 - (5) Slot machine.
 - (6) Video games of chance.
 - (7) Roulette wheel.
 - (8) Klondike table.
 - (9) Punchboard.
 - (10) Faro layout.
 - (11) Keno layout.
 - (12) Numbers ticket.
 - (13) Push card.
 - (14) Jar ticket.
 - (15) Pull tab.
 - (16) Big six.”

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to each riverboat licensee and each riverboat license applicant.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. ADOPTION OF THE AMENDMENT TO 68 IAC 10-1.

The Commission adopts the following amendment to 68 IAC 10-1 pending completion of the promulgation process:

- (1) Baccarat or Mini Baccarat.
- (2) Twenty-one or Blackjack.
- (3) Poker, including Caribbean Stud Poker, Let-It-Ride, and Pai-Gow Poker.
- (4) Craps.
- (5) Slot machine.
- (6) Video games of chance.
- (7) Roulette wheel.
- (8) Klondike table.
- (9) Keno layout.
- (10) Big six.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.

SECTION 5. EXPIRATION DATE.

This RESOLUTION expires thirty (30) days from the date and time that the Secretary of State accepts 68 IAC 10-1 for filing.


