

RESOLUTION 1996-22

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND PRESCRIBING THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN SUPPLIER LICENSE APPLICATION FORM

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. The Commission has adopted final rules concerning the transfer of an ownership interest in a supplier license pursuant to RESOLUTION 1995-21. Within these rules, the Commission requires that a supplier file certain information with the Commission.
2. The application for transfer of ownership interest in supplier license form has been prepared by Commission staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN SUPPLIER LICENSE APPLICATION FORM.

The Commission adopts the Transfer of Ownership Interest in Supplier License Application Form (copy attached to original). The Transfer of Ownership Interest in Supplier License Application Form is to be filed in accordance with 68 IAC 5-1 and 68 IAC 5-2.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.


This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.
