

**RESOLUTION 1996- 32**

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING LOGICAL SOLUTIONS INTERNATIONAL  
INC. THE ABILITY TO INSTALL ITS ACCOUNTING SYSTEM  
ON THE MAJESTIC STAR AND TRUMP RIVERBOATS  
PRIOR TO RECEIPT OF A TEMPORARY SUPPLIER'S LICENSE**

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. Logical Solutions International, Inc. ("LSI") supplies the accounting software program that assists the riverboat licensee in tracking the adjusted gross revenue, the amount on which the riverboat licensee pays wagering taxes. The supplier of the accounting software program is required to be licensed as a supplier pursuant to 68 IAC 2-2-2. The Majestic Star Casino LLC (Majestic Star) and Trump Indiana, Inc. ("Trump") wish to purchase their accounting programs from LSI (copies of letters attached).
2. LSI submitted a complete application for a supplier's license and the \$5,000 application fee to the Commission on April 10, 1996.
3. Delaying the installation, only, of the accounting software program until after the preliminary background investigation can be completed by the Indiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Section, to ensure that LSI meets the criteria set forth in IC 4-33-7-3 for licensure as a supplier will delay the opening of Majestic Star and Trump and does not serve any statutory purpose.
4. The Indiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Section, has begun the background investigation on LSI.
5. Majestic Star and Trump are aware that the preliminary investigation has not been completed on IEP, and has agreed that the surveillance equipment will be removed if the Commission determines that LSI is not suitable for licensure. Each has further agreed that the accounting software program will not be relied upon or utilized for revenue purposes until approved by the Commission staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

**SECTION 1. SCOPE.**

This resolution applies to LSI.

**SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.**

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

**SECTION 3. ACTION GRANTING LSI THE ABILITY TO INSTALL ITS ACCOUNTING SYSTEM ON THE MAJESTIC STAR AND TRUMP RIVERBOATS PRIOR TO RECEIPT OF A TEMPORARY SUPPLIER'S LICENSE.**

The Commission grants LSI the ability to install its accounting software program on the Majestic Star and Trump riverboats prior to the receipt of a temporary supplier's license. LSI must cooperate fully with the Indiana State Police, Gaming Enforcement Section, in processing its application for a temporary supplier's license. LSI, Majestic Star, and Trump are hereby notified that if LSI is not found suitable for licensure, the accounting software program must be removed from the riverboats, and the results from that software program may not be relied upon when computing the amount of wagering tax due pursuant to IC 4-33 until approved by the Commission staff.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.

**SECTION 5. EXPIRATION DATE.**


This RESOLUTION expires upon the issuance or denial of a temporary supplier's license to LSI.
