

RESOLUTION 1996- 43

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING 68 IAC 5.1; 68 IAC 1-13; 68 IAC 2-2-6.1;
68 IAC 2-3-6.1; 68 IAC 3-4; 68 IAC 10-6; AND 68 IAC 10-7;
AND AMENDMENTS TO 68 IAC 2-6-37; 68 IAC 14-3-2; 68 IAC 14-3-3;
68 IAC 15-9-1; AND 68 IAC 15-9-4 FOR PUBLICATION AS PROPOSED RULES**

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. The Commission has begun promulgation of these rules, or plans to begin promulgation of these rules pursuant to IC 4-22. All of these rules except 68 IAC 1-13 are to be published in the *Indiana Register* on October 1, 1996. The Commission will begin the promulgation process on 68 IAC 1-13 on September 1, 1996, and the rule will be published thereafter. A public hearing is to be held on these rules in compliance with IC 4-22.
2. The promulgation process for the final promulgation of these rules will take approximately four (4) to six (6) months.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to each applicant, each licensee, each riverboat license applicant, any person who does business with an applicant or licensee, and any person who is a patron of a Riverboat Gambling Operation.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED RULES.

The Commission adopts the following proposed rules pending the promulgation process:

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.

This RESOLUTION expires thirty (30) days from the date and time that the Secretary of State accepts the rules listed in Section 3 for filing.


