

RESOLUTION 1996- 54

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AUTHORITY
TO INITIATE DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS AGAINST RIVERBOAT
LICENSEES, SUPPLIER LICENSEES, AND OCCUPATIONAL LICENSEES**

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6:

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. The Commission has entered into the regulatory phase.
2. The Commission needs to begin initiating disciplinary actions against riverboat licensees, supplier licensees, and occupational licensees for violating IC 4-33 or 68 IAC, or both.
3. In order to efficiently and timely resolve these matters, the Executive Director or the Executive Director’s designee needs the ability to initiate disciplinary actions against riverboat licensees, supplier licensees, and occupational licensees on an expedited basis.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to all riverboat licensees, supplier licensees, and occupational licensees.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. GRANT OF AUTHORITY TO EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.

The Executive Director or the Executive Director’s designee is hereby granted the authority to initiate disciplinary actions against riverboat licensees, supplier licensees, and occupational licensees. All settlement offers entered into between the parties and written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations issued by an Administrative Law Judge will be presented to the Commission at a meeting held under 68 IAC 1-2-5 before the settlement offer or the recommendations are accepted and deemed a final Commission action.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.
