

RESOLUTION 1997-28

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING 68 IAC 1-16; 68 IAC 2-3-9.2; 68 IAC 2-3-9.3 AND AMENDMENTS TO 68 IAC 9-4-5; 68 IAC 11-2-1; 68 IAC 11-3-1; AND 68 IAC 15-6-5 FOR PUBLICATION AS PROPOSED RULES

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. The Commission has begun promulgation of these rules pursuant to IC 4-22. The rules are to be published in the *Indiana Register* as soon as all of the statutory requirements of IC 4-22 are met. A public hearing is to be held on these rules in compliance with IC 4-22.
2. The promulgation process for the final promulgation of the rules will take a minimum of four (4) to six (6) months.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. SCOPE

This resolution applies to each applicant, each licensee, each riverboat license applicant, any person who does business with an applicant or licensee, and any person who is a patron of a Riverboat Gambling Operation.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED RULES.

The Commission adopts the following proposed rules pending the promulgation process:

SECTION 5. EXPIRATION DATE.


This RESOLUTION expires thirty (30) days from the date and time that the Secretary of State accepts the rules listed in Section 3 for filing.
