

**SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) by and through its Executive Director, Ernest E. Yelton and Blue Chip Casino, LLC (“Blue Chip”) desire to compromise and settle this matter prior to the initiation of a disciplinary proceeding pursuant to 68 IAC 13-1-18(a). The parties stipulate and agree that the following facts are true:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Pursuant to 68 IAC 6-3-4, riverboat licensees must adopt internal control procedures to “ensure that voluntarily excluded persons do not receive check cashing privileges or extensions of credit, whether directly through the riverboat licensee or operating agent, or through a supplier contracting with a riverboat licensee or operating agent on property hired for the purpose of check cashing or extensions of credit or both.”
2. On March 10, 2006 a Blue Chip Cage Cashier cashed a check for a VEP patron. The casino was notified by Central Credit that the patron was on the VEP list.

**RECOMMENDATION TO THE COMMISSION**


The actions of Blue Chip violated IC 4-33 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, as well as Blue Chip’s approved internal control procedures. Commission staff and Blue Chip agree that a sanction be imposed. Commission staff recommends, and Blue Chip will agree to pay a fine in the amount of \$10,000.

Upon execution and approval of this Settlement Agreement, Blue Chip and the Commission staff agree to submit this Settlement Agreement to the Commission for review and final Commission action. Upon approval of the Settlement Agreement by the Commission, Blue Chip agrees to remit payment in the amount of \$10,000 and waives all rights to judicial review. This Settlement Agreement shall be binding upon the Commission and Blue Chip.
