**ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE RENEWAL OF SUPPLIER'S LICENSES**

In accordance with and subject to Indiana Code 4-33 and 68 IAC 2-2 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") has previously issued permanent supplier's licenses to (1) Glory U.S.A., Inc., (2) Gaming Partners International SAS (3) VendingData Corporation (4) Western Money Systems (5) Global Surveillance Association (6) Chipco International (7) Paltronics, Inc., (8) Southwest Surveillance Systems and (9) IEP, Ltd.

A supplier's license is valid for a period of one (1) year and in accordance with IC 4-33-7-8 and 68 IAC 2-2-8, a supplier's license must be renewed annually along with the payment of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) for the annual renewal fee. Each of these licensees has requested renewal of licensure and the renewal fees have been paid in accordance with 68 IAC 2-2-3(c) and 68 IAC 2-2-8. The Commission has determined that the above-named supplier licensees remain in substantial compliance with IC 4-33 and are suitable to hold a supplier's license.

The Commission hereby **GRANTS** renewal of the licenses of each of the suppliers for a period of one year as specified below:

- 1) Glory U.S.A., Inc.: valid September 26, 2006 through September 25, 2007
- 2) Gaming Partners International SAS: valid September 26, 2006 through September 25, 2007
- 3) VendingData Corporation: valid September 27, 2006 through September 26, 2007
- 4) Western Money Systems: valid October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007
- 5) Global Surveillance Associates: valid October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007
- 6) Chipco International: valid October 23, 2006 through October 22, 2007
- 7) Paltronics, Inc.: valid November 17, 2006 through November 16, 2007
- 8) Southwest Surveillance Systems: valid December 3, 2006 through December 2, 2007
- 9) IEP, Ltd.: valid December 15, 2006 through December 16, 2007


Each licensee shall be responsible for notifying the Commission of its desire to be considered for a subsequent license renewal at least thirty (30) days before the expiration of the license.
