**ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING THE RENEWAL OF SUPPLIER'S LICENSES**

In accordance with and subject to Indiana Code 4-33 and 68 IAC 2-2 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") has previously issued permanent supplier's licenses to: (1) Midwest Game Supply, Co. (2) IGT (3) Fidelity National Transaction Services, Inc. (Formerly Certegy & GameCash, Inc.) (4) Atlantic City Coin & Slot Service Co., Inc. (AC Coin) (5) WMS Gaming Inc. (6) Bally Technologies, Inc. (Alliance Gaming Corp.) (7) Dallmann Systems, Inc.


A supplier's license is valid for a period of one (1) year and in accordance with IC 4-33-7-8 and 68 IAC 2-2-8, a supplier's license must be renewed annually along with the payment of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) for the annual renewal fee. Each of these licensees has requested renewal of licensure and the renewal fees have been paid in accordance with 68 IAC 2-2-3(c) and 68 IAC 2-2-8. The Commission has determined that the above-named supplier licensees remain in substantial compliance with IC 4-33 and are suitable to hold a supplier's license.

The Commission hereby **GRANTS** renewal of the licenses of each of the suppliers for a period of one year as specified below:

- 1) Midwest Game Supply: valid January 27, 2007 through January 26, 2008
- 2) IGT: valid January 26, 2007 through January 25, 2008
- 3) Fidelity National Transaction Services, Inc.: valid February 26, 2007 through February 25, 2008
- 4) AC Coin: valid February 26, 2007 through February 25, 2008
- 5) WMS Gaming, Inc.: valid March 17, 2007 through March 16, 2008
- 6) Bally Technologies, Inc.: valid March 30, 2007 through March 29, 2008
- 7) Dallmann Systems, Inc.: valid March 31, 2007 through March 30, 2008


Each licensee shall be responsible for notifying the Commission of its desire to be considered for a subsequent license renewal at least thirty (30) days before the expiration of the license.
