

ORDER 2011-131

**APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION AND J.R.**

On or about April 9, 2011, J.R. ("Fighter") obtained from the Indiana Gaming Commission a professional boxing license. On April 9, 2011, Fighter participated in a professional boxing bout in Hammond, Indiana.

Pursuant to LSA Document 11-168(E), Section 60(c), Fighter submitted to a drug test immediately following the conclusion of his bout. His post-bout drug test results indicated a positive test result for Cannabinoids.

Under IC 4-33-22 and LSA Document 11-168(E), Section 61, a confirmed positive drug test result may result in disciplinary action against a fighter's license.

On April 28, 2011, Commission staff sent a letter to Fighter regarding this matter. This letter offered to settle the matter in lieu of commission staff filing a complaint and pursuing disciplinary action.

Commission staff and Fighter have agreed to settle this matter. The terms of the settlement agreement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, require Sanctioning Body to pay a fine of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750).

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.


