

ORDER 2011-169

AN ORDER AFFIRMING THE CIVIL PENALTY AGAINST PATRICIA STRICKLAND FOR VIOLATION OF HER PLACEMENT ON THE STATEWIDE EXCLUSION LIST

On April 21, 2010, Strickland was placed on the Statewide Exclusion List, barring her presence on the gaming floor at any casino or racino in Indiana. On June 18, 2011, Strickland was found at the Ameristar Casino in East Chicago, Indiana in violation of the terms of the placement on the Statewide Exclusion List. While in the gaming area of the Ameristar Casino on June 18, 2011, Strickland won a \$1,506 slot machine jackpot.

On June 28, 2011, the Commission staff initiated a civil penalty administrative action by filing a complaint against Strickland in the amount of \$1,506 for being in violation of 68 IAC 6-1-4.5. Strickland failed to file an Answer to the Commission's complaint. On August 23, 2011, the Administrative Law Judge issued a Default Judgment Order against Strickland for failure to respond to the Commission staff's civil penalty administrative complaint.

COMMISSION ACTION

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS

the Administrative Law Judge's Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.


