

ORDER 2015-183
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OF THE APPEAL OF THE
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #15-61

On September 17, 2015, in Order 2015-119, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) from John Doe #15-61 for a violation as a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Specifically John Doe #15-61 won cash equivalents while in the gaming area of the Horseshoe Hammond Casino in Hammond, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #15-61 timely filed an appeal of Order 2015-119 and Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook was assigned to the case. On October 26, 2015, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #15-61, which was approved by Judge Cook.


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:
