

ORDER 2017-66
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING
THE PAID FANTASY SPORTS OPERATOR LICENSE OF FANTASYDRAFT, LLC.

In accordance with and subject to Ind. Code art. 4-33, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) has completed its background and financial investigation of FantasyDraft, LLC. (“FantasyDraft”) and has determined that FantasyDraft is suitable to hold a paid fantasy sports game operator’s license (“game operator license”).


The issuance of a game operator’s license is conditioned upon the following:

1. Full compliance with all applicable emergency rules, all applicable provisions of Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code and all applicable orders and resolutions issued by the Commission;
2. Continued satisfaction of all requirements set forth in Ind. Code ch. 4-33-24; and
3. Submission of all necessary requests for annual renewal of the operator’s license pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-24-17 along with timely payment of the annual renewal fee pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-33-24-15.

The Commission has determined that FantasyDraft is in compliance with Ind. Code ch. 4-33-24 and is suitable to hold a game operator’s license. In accordance with and subject to the conditions set forth herein, the Commission hereby **GRANTS** a game operator’s license to FantasyDraft for a period of one year beginning June 29, 2017 through June 28, 2018.


