

**ORDER 2019-131**  
**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION**  
**CONCERNING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OF THE APPEAL OF THE**  
**VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #19-20**

On May 30, 2019, through Order 2019-59, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved the remittance of One Thousand Forty Five dollars (\$1,045.00), less applicable taxes, from John Doe #19-20 for a violation as a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program. Specifically, John Doe #19-20 won cash equivalents while in the gaming area of the Blue Chip Casino in Michigan City, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #19-20 timely filed an appeal of Order 2019-59. Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #19-20, and on July 16, 2019, Commission staff and John Doe #19-20 fully executed a settlement agreement.


Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
