

ORDER 2020-108

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING THE
PERMANENT SPORTS WAGERING VENDOR LICENSE OF
CROWN IN GAMING, LLC**

In accordance with and subject to Ind. Code ch. 4-38-6 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, and the Commission's emergency rules concerning sports wagering, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") has completed its background and financial investigation of Crown IN Gaming, LLC d/b/a DraftKings ("DraftKings") and has determined that DraftKings is suitable to receive a permanent sports wagering vendor license.

The issuance of the vendor license is conditioned upon continued compliance with the following list of requirements:

- 1) Full compliance with all relevant orders, resolutions, and directives issued by the Commission.
- 2) Continued compliance with Ind. Code art. 4-38, Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, and the Commission's emergency rules concerning sports wagering.
- 3) Submission of the required annual administrative fee described under Ind. Code 4-38-6-6. The fee must be submitted on or before one (1) year after the date that the vendor begins performing services under a contract with a certificate holder in the conduct of sports wagering operations under Ind. Code art. 4-38 and on each annual anniversary date thereafter. According to the Commission, DraftKings commenced sports wagering operations on October 3, 2019.

The Commission has determined that DraftKings is substantially compliant with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, and the Commission's emergency rules concerning sports wagering and is suitable to hold a sports wagering vendor license. In accordance with and subject to the conditions set forth herein, the Commission hereby **GRANTS** a vendor license to DraftKings for a period from October 3, 2020 through October 2, 2021.
