

ORDER 2020-111

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING THE
PERMANENT SPORTS WAGERING SERVICE PROVIDER LICENSE OF
ARISTOTLE INTERNATIONAL INC.**

In accordance with and subject to Ind. Code ch. 4-38-6 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, and the Commission's emergency rules concerning sports wagering, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") has completed its background and financial investigation of Aristotle International LLC ("Aristotle") and has determined that Aristotle is suitable to receive a permanent sports wagering service provider license.

The issuance of the sports wagering service provider license is conditioned upon continued compliance with the following list of requirements:

- 1) Full compliance with all relevant orders, resolutions, and directives issued by the Commission; and
- 2) Continued compliance with Ind. Code art. 4-38, Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, and the Commission's emergency rules concerning sports wagering.

The Commission has determined that Aristotle is substantially compliant with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, and the Commission's emergency rules concerning sports wagering and is suitable to hold a sports wagering service provider license. In accordance with and subject to the conditions set forth herein, the Commission hereby **GRANTS** a sports wagering service provider license to Aristotle.
