

**ORDER 2020-12**

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION APPROVING  
EMERGENCY ORDER 2020-VEN-02**

On or about December 20, 2019, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“the Commission”) received notice of Rush Street Interactive, LLC’s (“Rush Street”) intention to restructure its ownership. This would allow for a pathway for its key employees to obtain an ownership interest in Rush Street. On March 13, 2020 Commission staff completed its analysis of Rush Street’s proposed ownership restructuring. Commission staff found that approval of the restructuring request would pose no additional risk to the Commission as Rush Street and relevant key persons have been investigated previously and have had no issues with failing to comply with any Commission rules of regulations.


After obtaining the consent from one member of the Commission, Executive Director Tait exercised her authority under Resolution 2012-151 and issued Emergency Order 2020-VEN-02 on March 30, 2020, granting Rush Street’s request to restructure its ownership. Resolution 2012-151 requires the Executive Director to report action taken under it to the Commission at the next Commission meeting for ratification or other action by the Commission.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** Emergency Order 2020-VEN-02.
