

ORDER 2020-163

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION APPROVING
EMERGENCY ORDER 2020-SL-05**

In September 2020, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“the Commission”) received notice of GeoComply Solutions, Inc. (“GeoComply”) and GeoComply Global, Inc.’s (“GeoComply Global”) intent to form an amalgamated corporation. Post-amalgamation, the entity will be referred to as GeoComply Solutions, Inc. and be comprised of the same ownership and executive management. To date, the Commission has determined that GeoComply is substantially compliant with Indiana statutes and regulations and has satisfied the requirements for a transfer of ownership under 68 IAC 5-2. Approval of this transfer of ownership request would pose no additional risk to the Commission, as GeoComply and key persons of GeoComply have been investigated previously and have had no issues with failing to comply with any Commission rules or regulations.

After obtaining the consent from one member of the Commission, Executive Director Tait exercised her authority under Resolution 2012-151 and issued Emergency Order 2020-SL-05 on September 15, 2020, granting GeoComply and GeoComply Global’s request to form an amalgamated entity. Resolution 2012-151 requires the Executive Director to report action taken under it to the Commission at the next Commission meeting for ratification or other action by the Commission.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** Emergency Order 2020-SL-05.
