AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION REGARDING REQUEST
FOR WAIVER OF FELONY DISQUALIFICATION FOR DAVID ROHER

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”), having considered this matter, hereby:

the Findings and of Fact and Recommendation of the hearing officer, and thereby:

~~APPROVES~~ REJECTS

the application for felony waiver as to a felony disclosed by David Rohrer in his October 21, 2020 felony waiver application.

The felony waiver is only for a **LEVEL 3** license to work as a Maintenance Worker for Hollywood Casino. Mr. Rohrer may receive a temporary license and be issued a permanent license upon satisfactory completion of a routine licensing investigation and background check. A new felony waiver application must be submitted to the Commission for consideration in the event of a transfer, promotion, or job title change.
