2022 HOUSING INVENTORY COUNT

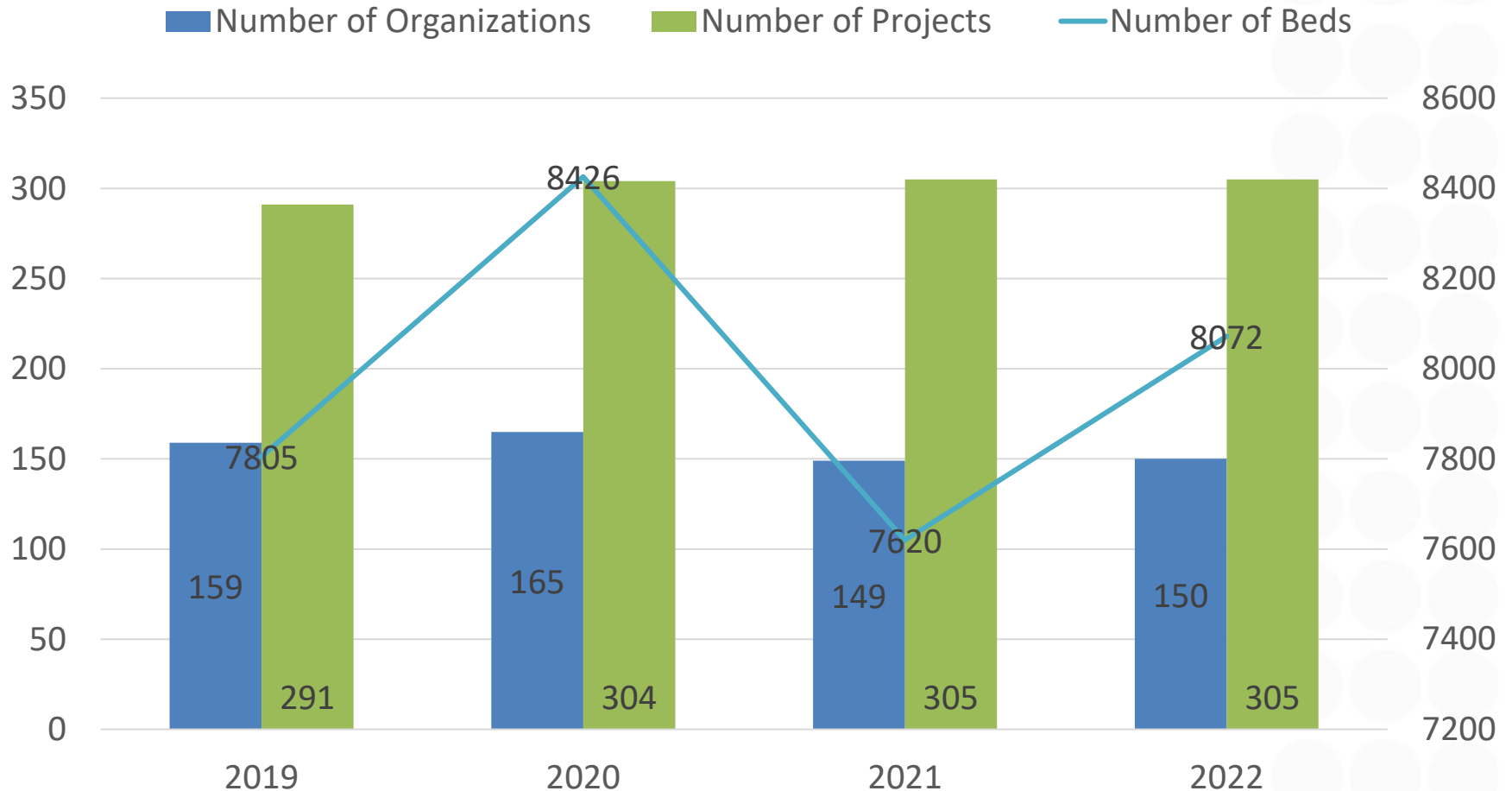
- HIC due date: 5/6/2022. IHCD submitted on 4/21/22
- The HIC covers ES, TH, SH, PH (PSH, RRH, VASH) programs
- It provides information of the capacity level for each program type in our BoS
- An inventory of # beds, #units, target population, people in projects on the night of the count, funding, etc. in our BoS
- Provides information that could help determine the needs and challenges of each region and the BoS as a whole

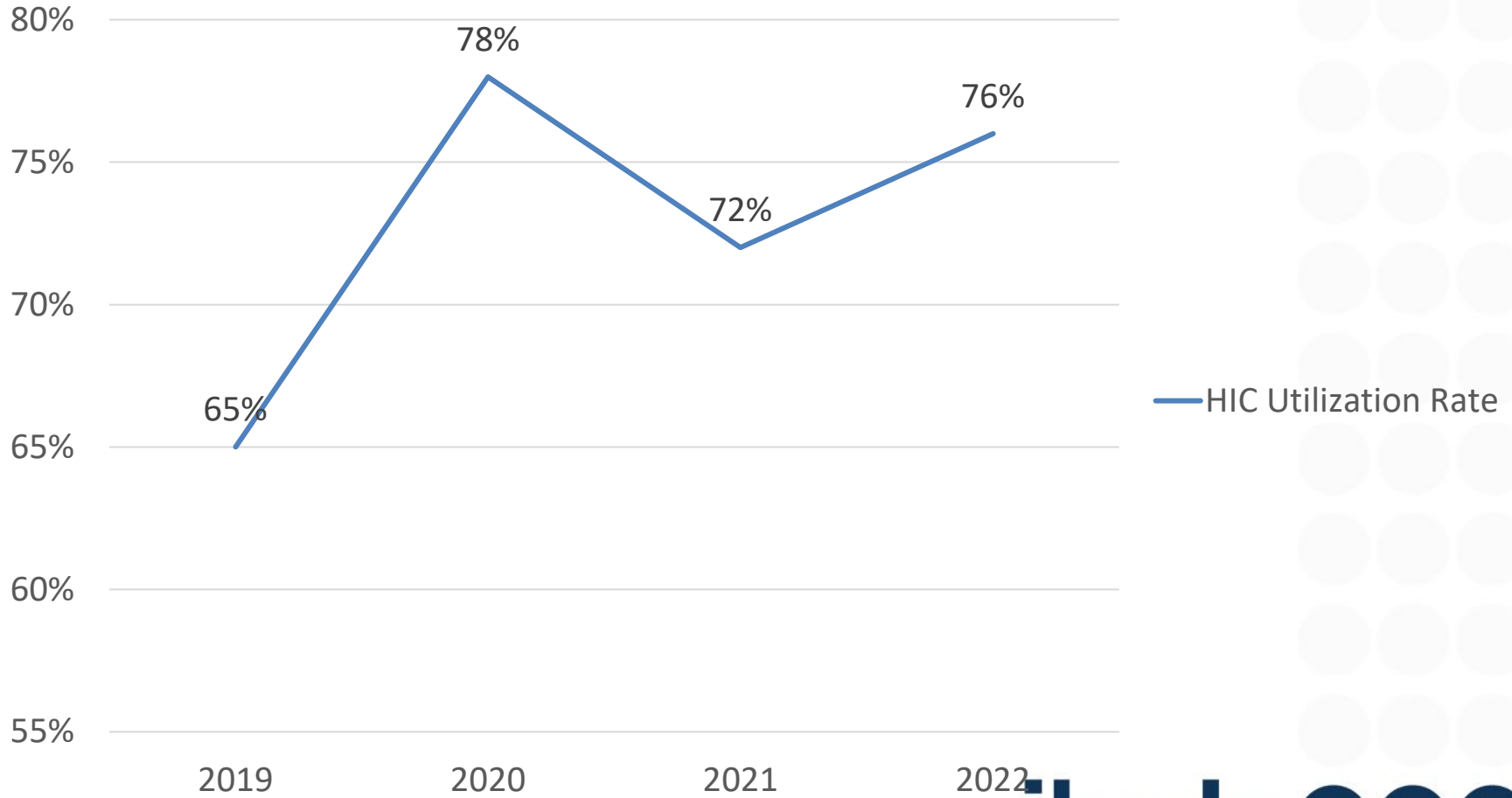

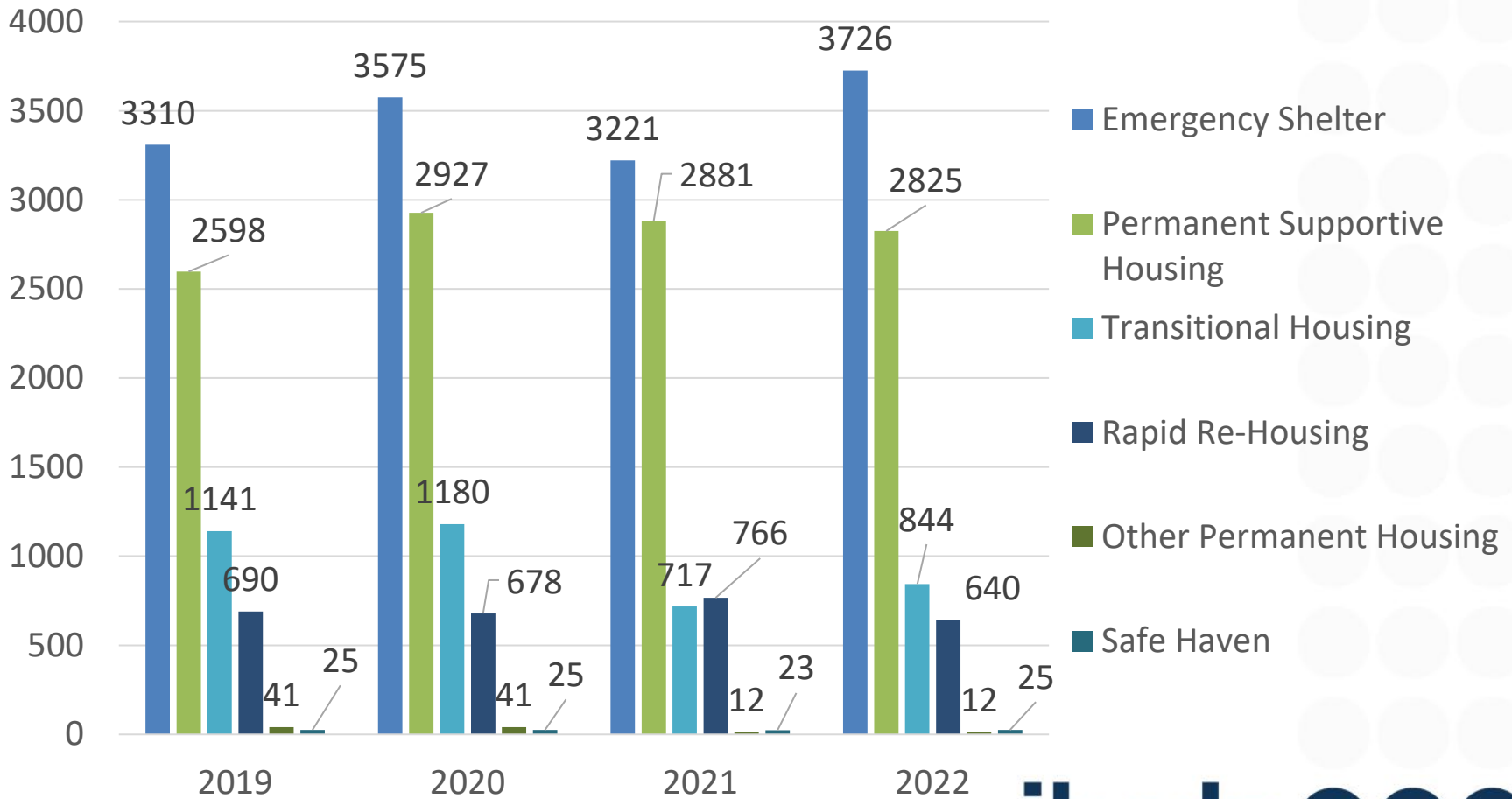
HIC OVERVIEW FROM 2019 - 2022



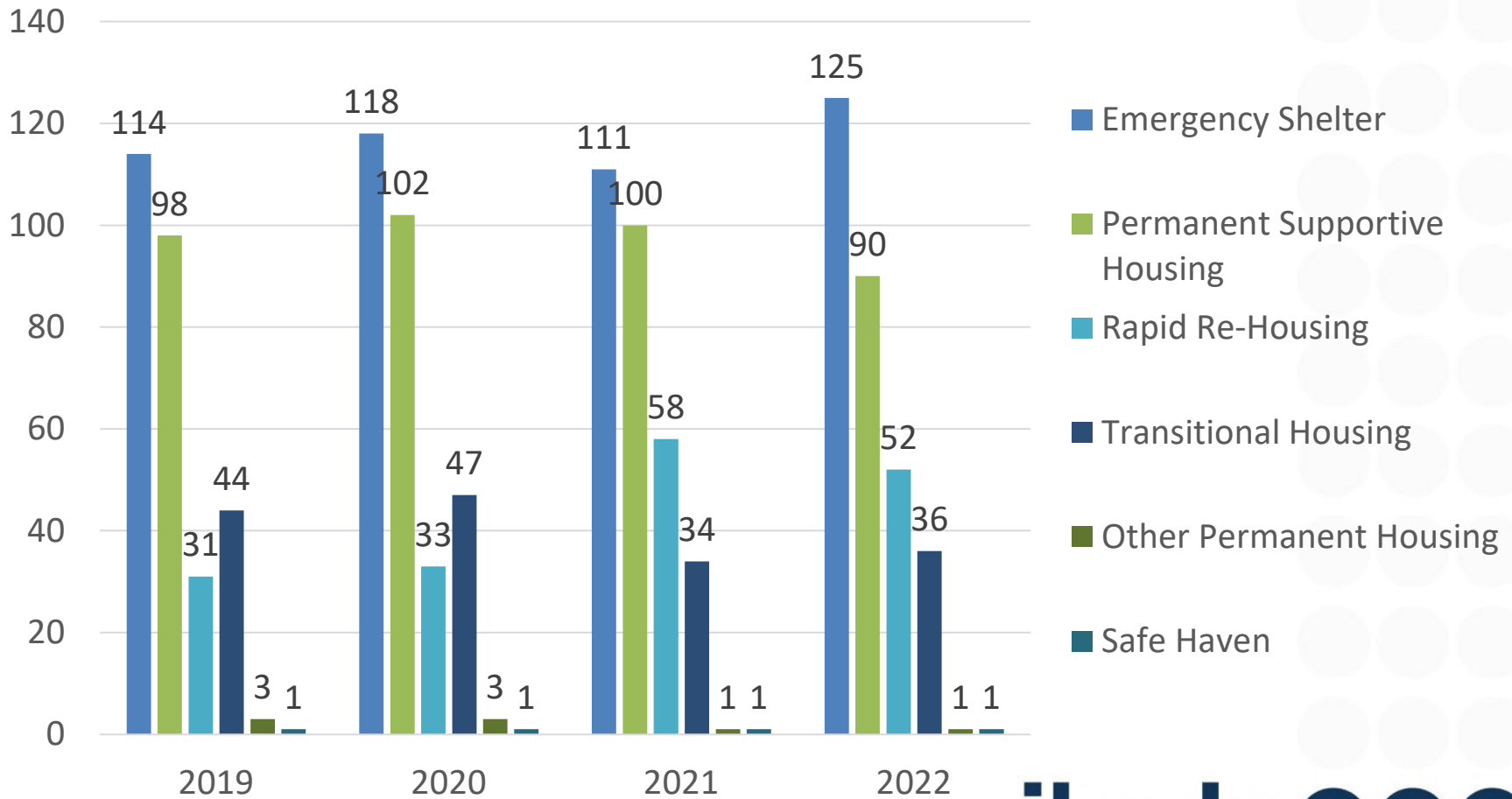
UTILIZATION RATE 2019-2022

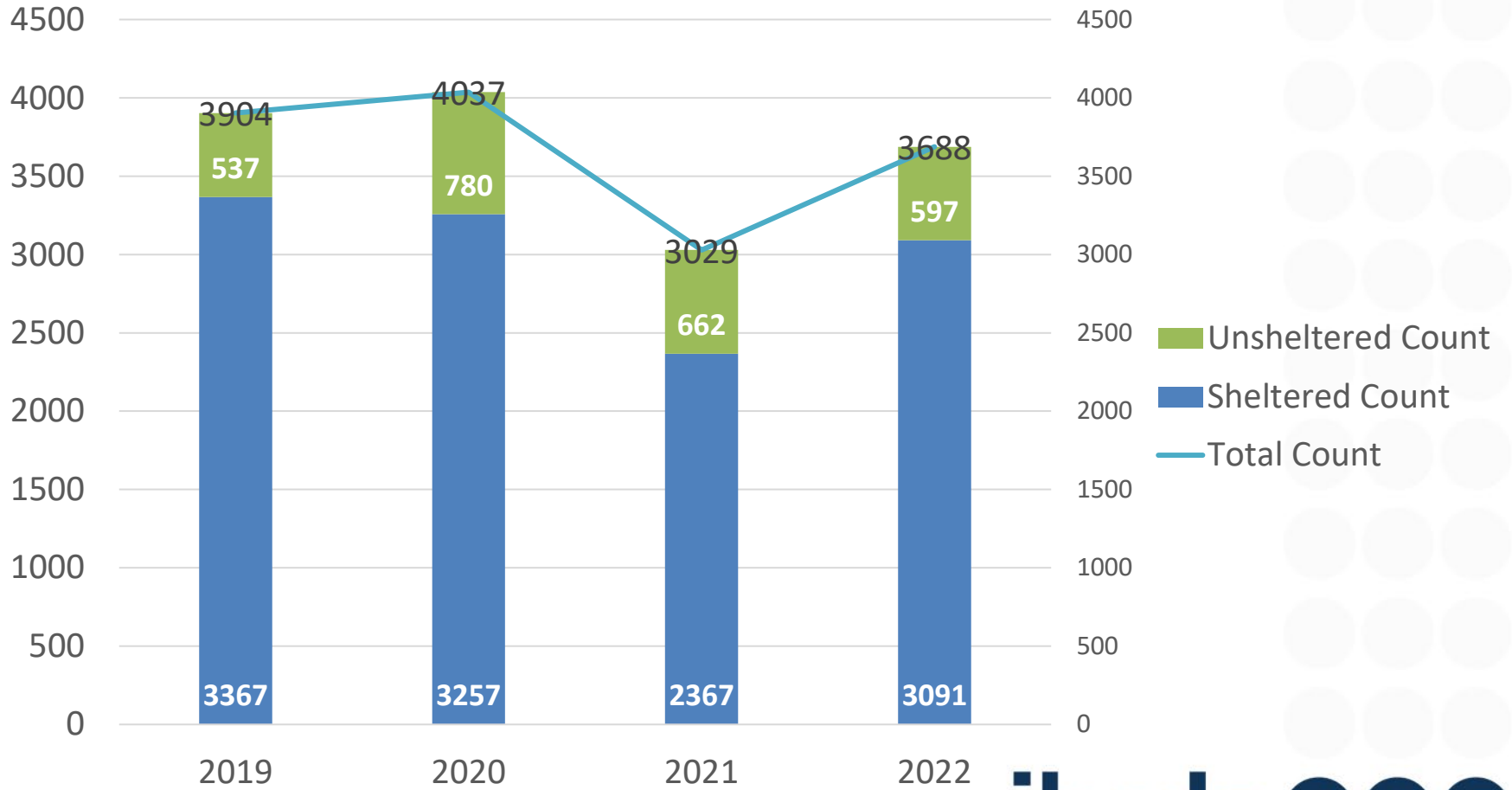

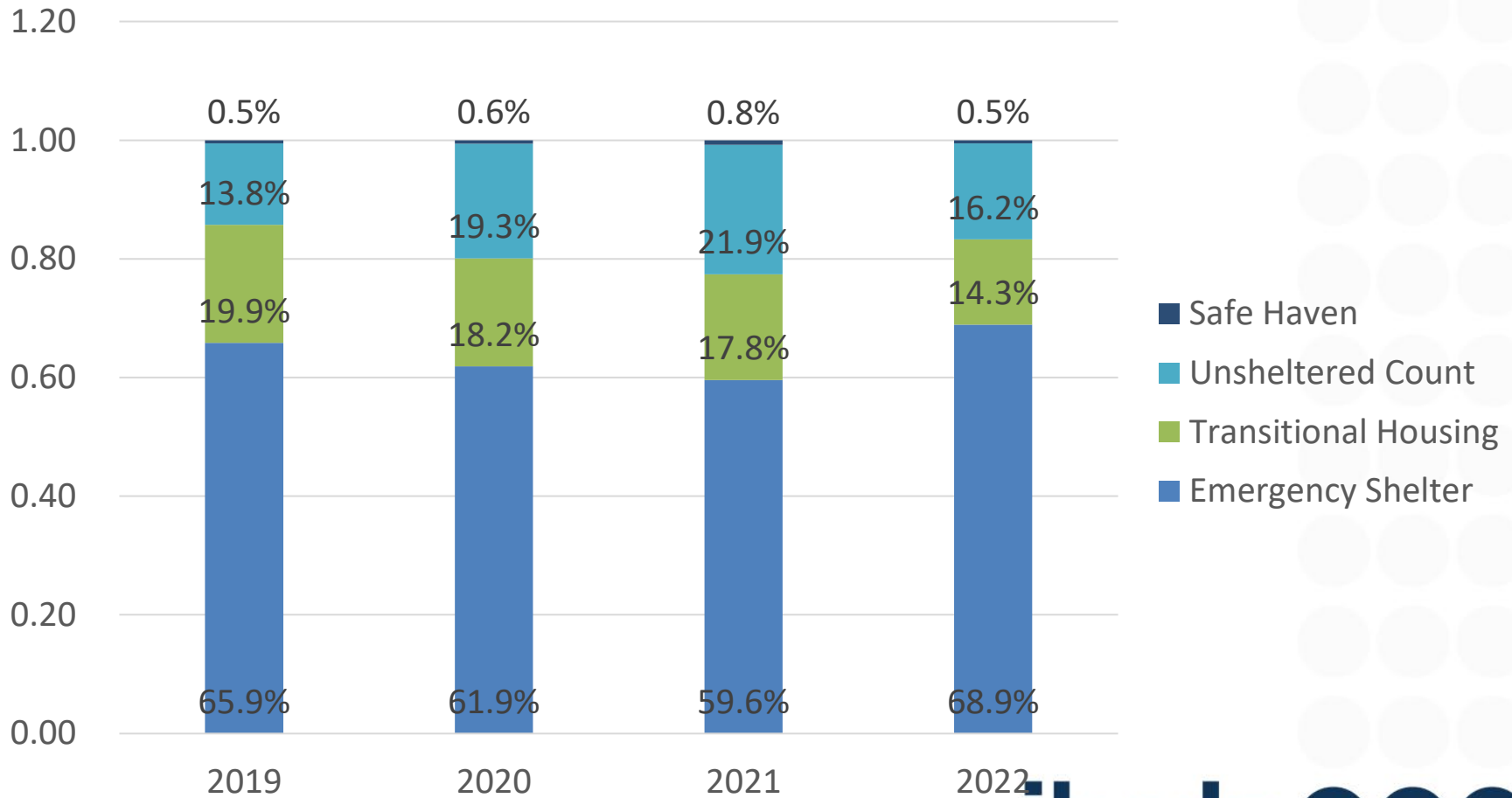
2022 POINT IN TIME COUNT

- PIT due date: 5/6/2022. IHCDCA submitted on 4/21/22
- Duplicate or incomplete surveys, individuals living in doubled-up situations (with family or friends), precariously housed, or on the edge of becoming homeless are not counted in the PIT count
- Only data correctly entered in HMIS and DV ClientTrack is reported to HUD and pulled through PIT Reports
- It covers ES, TH, and SH programs, as well as the unsheltered count

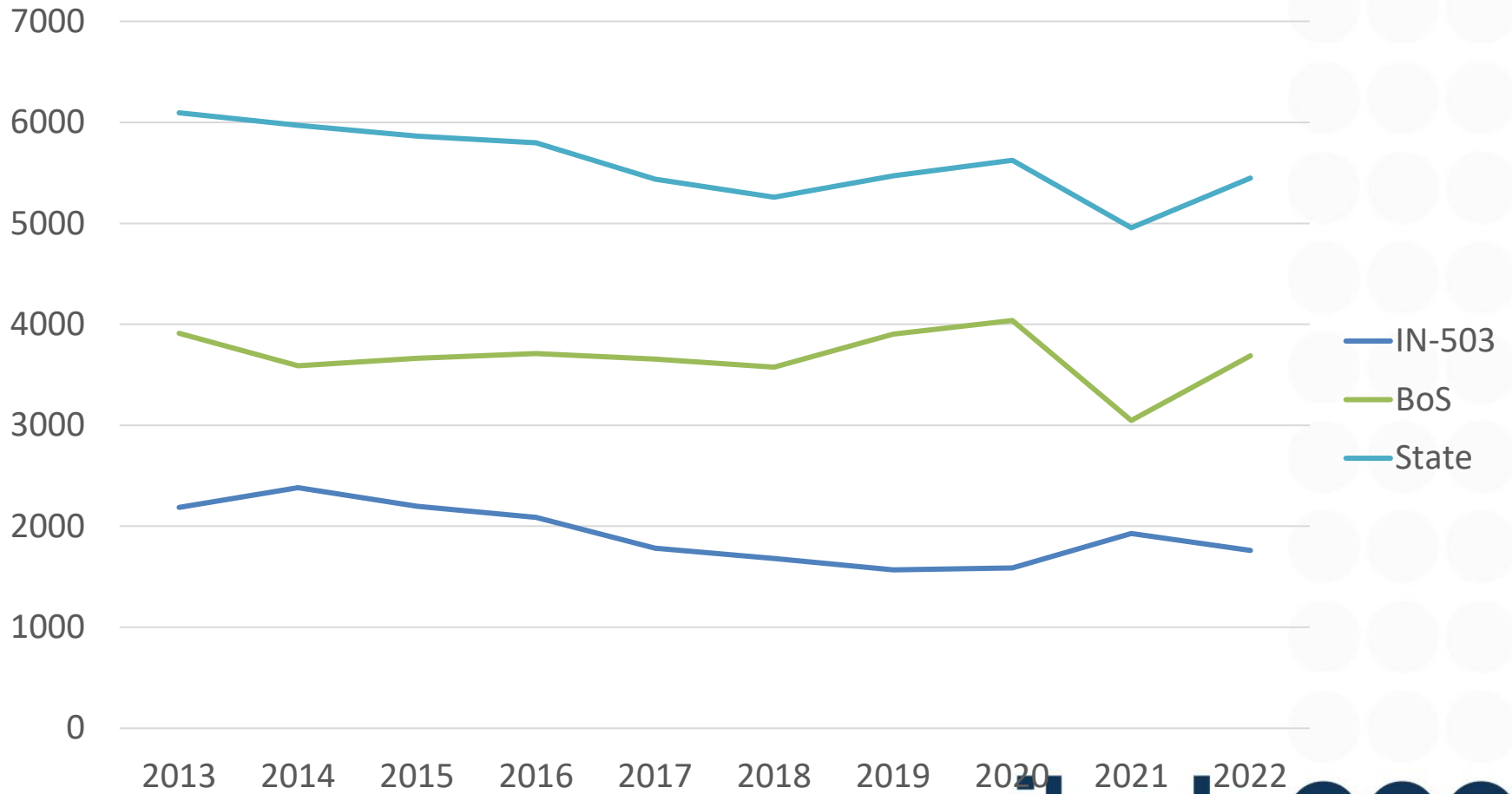
SHELTERED AND UNSHELTERED COUNT FROM 2019-2022



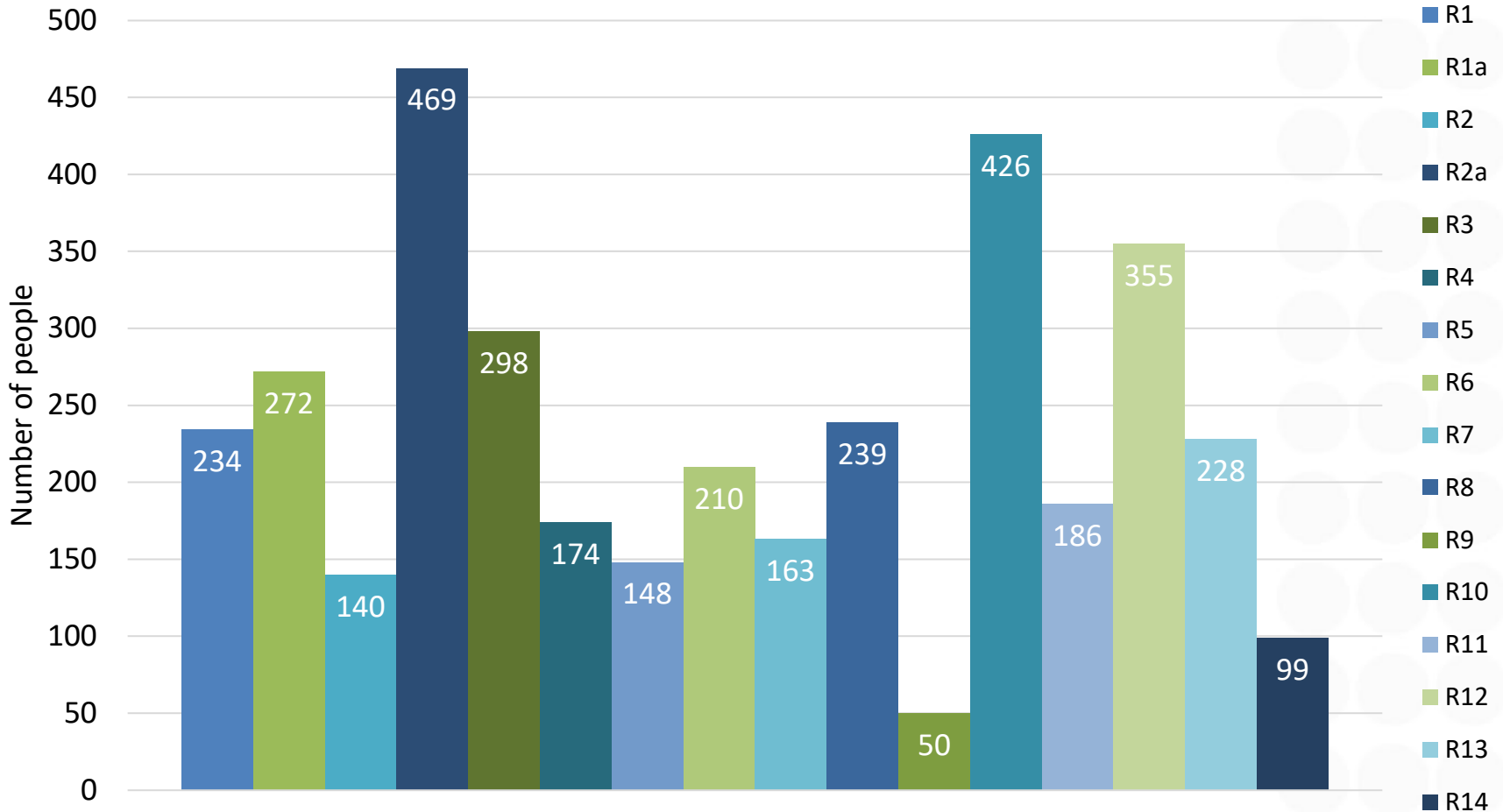
POINT-IN-TIME NUMBERS PER PROJECT TYPE 2019-2022



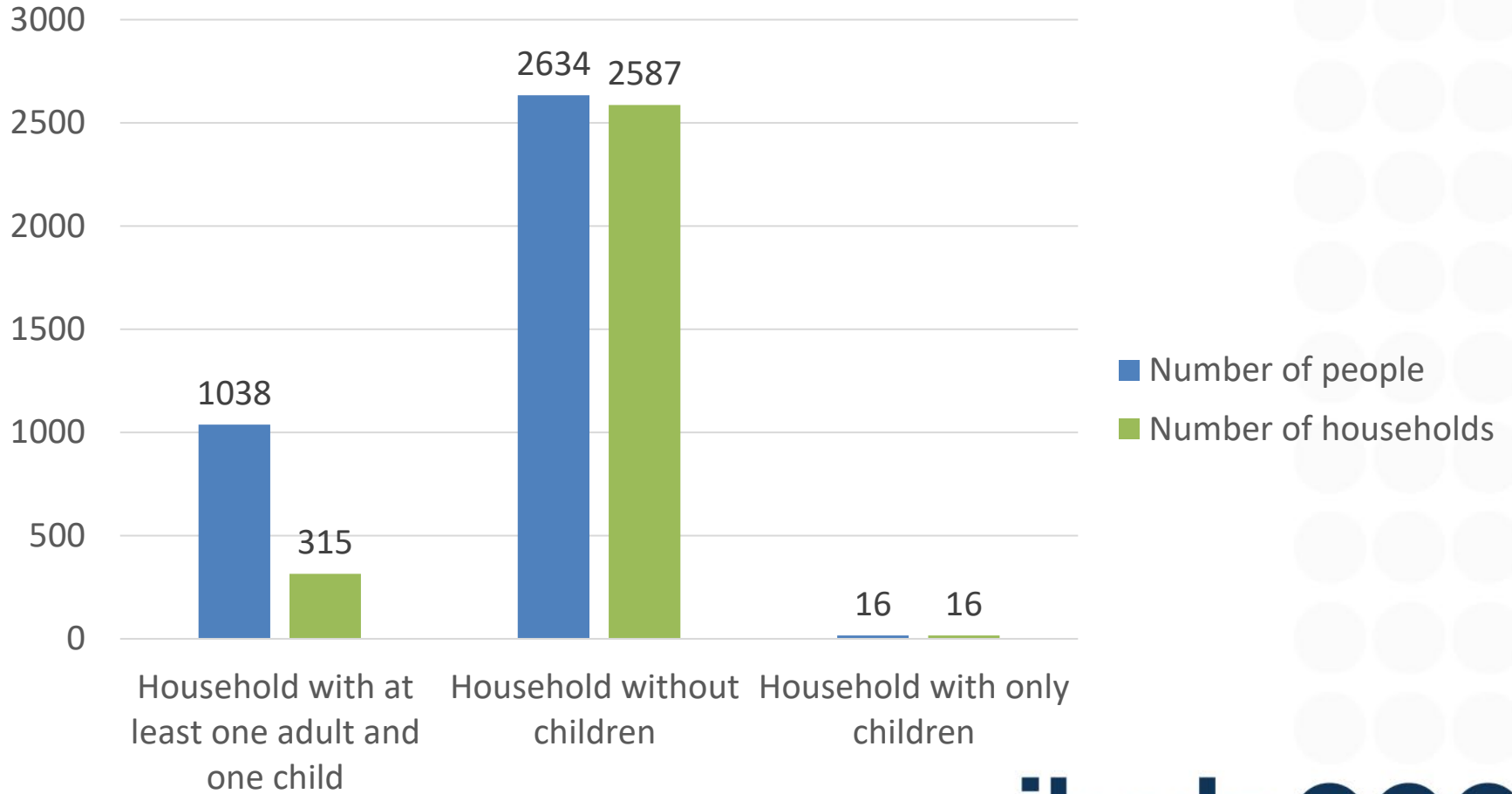
POINT IN TIME TRENDS 2013 – 2022

2021/2022 Comparison

- 46 of 91 participated in the 2021 PIT count for our BoS
- 68 of 91 counties participated in the 2022 PIT count

2022 Sheltered count

- 68 counties participated
- 2 exempt- Brown and Crawford
- 21 counties did not participate

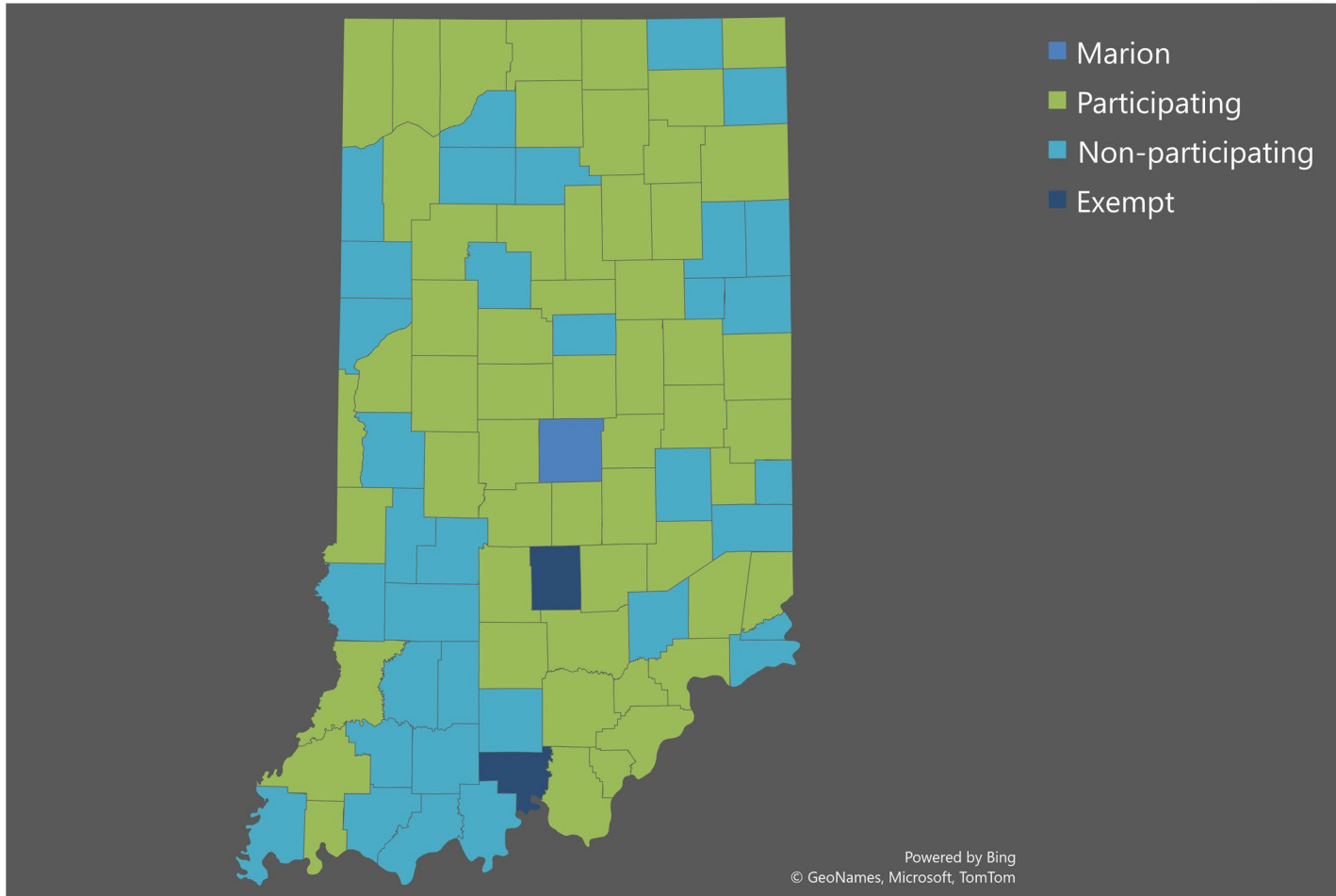
2022 Unsheltered count

- Of the 68 counties that participated:
 - 31 counties had no unsheltered PIT count
 - 37 counties provided unsheltered data

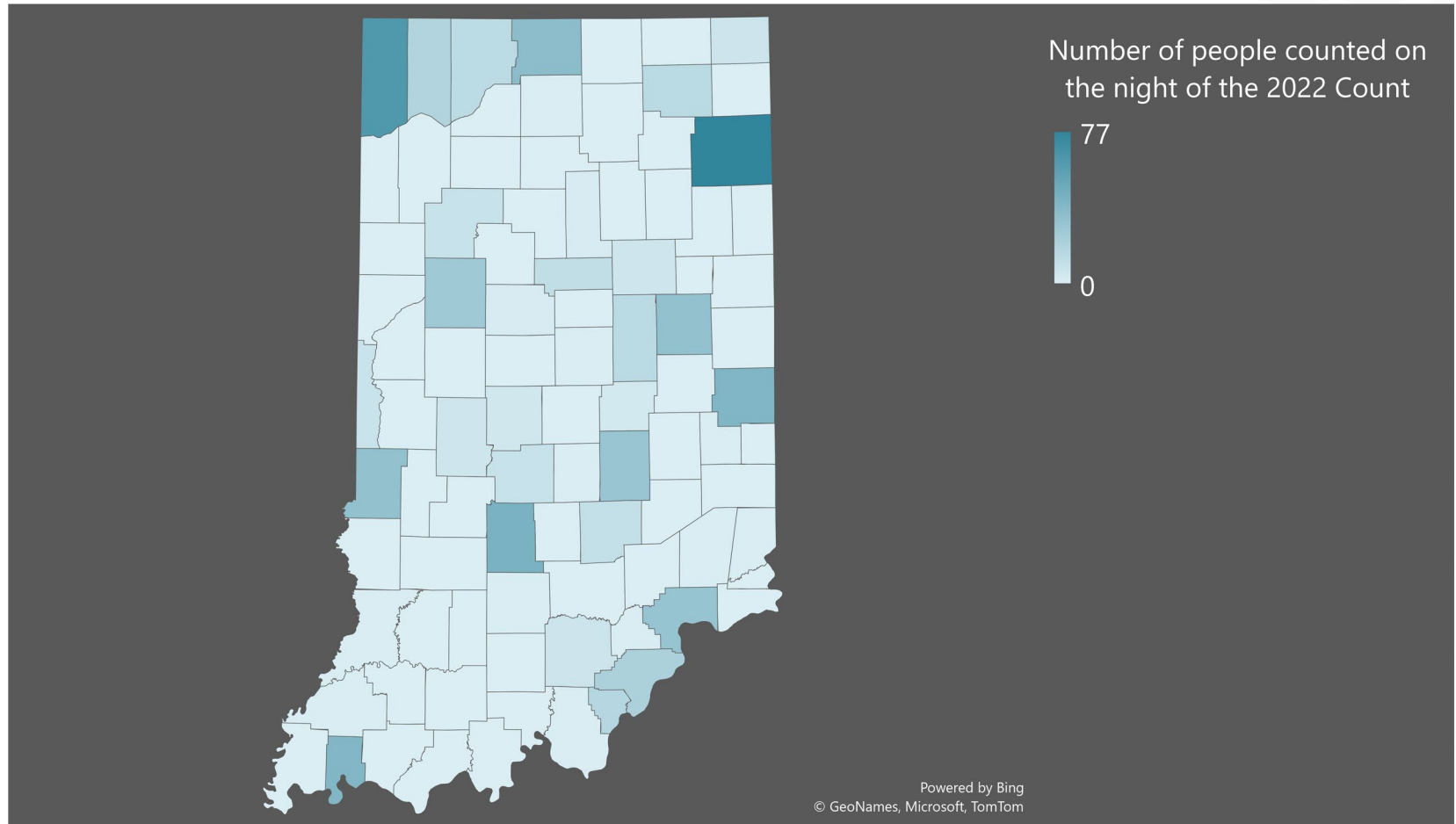

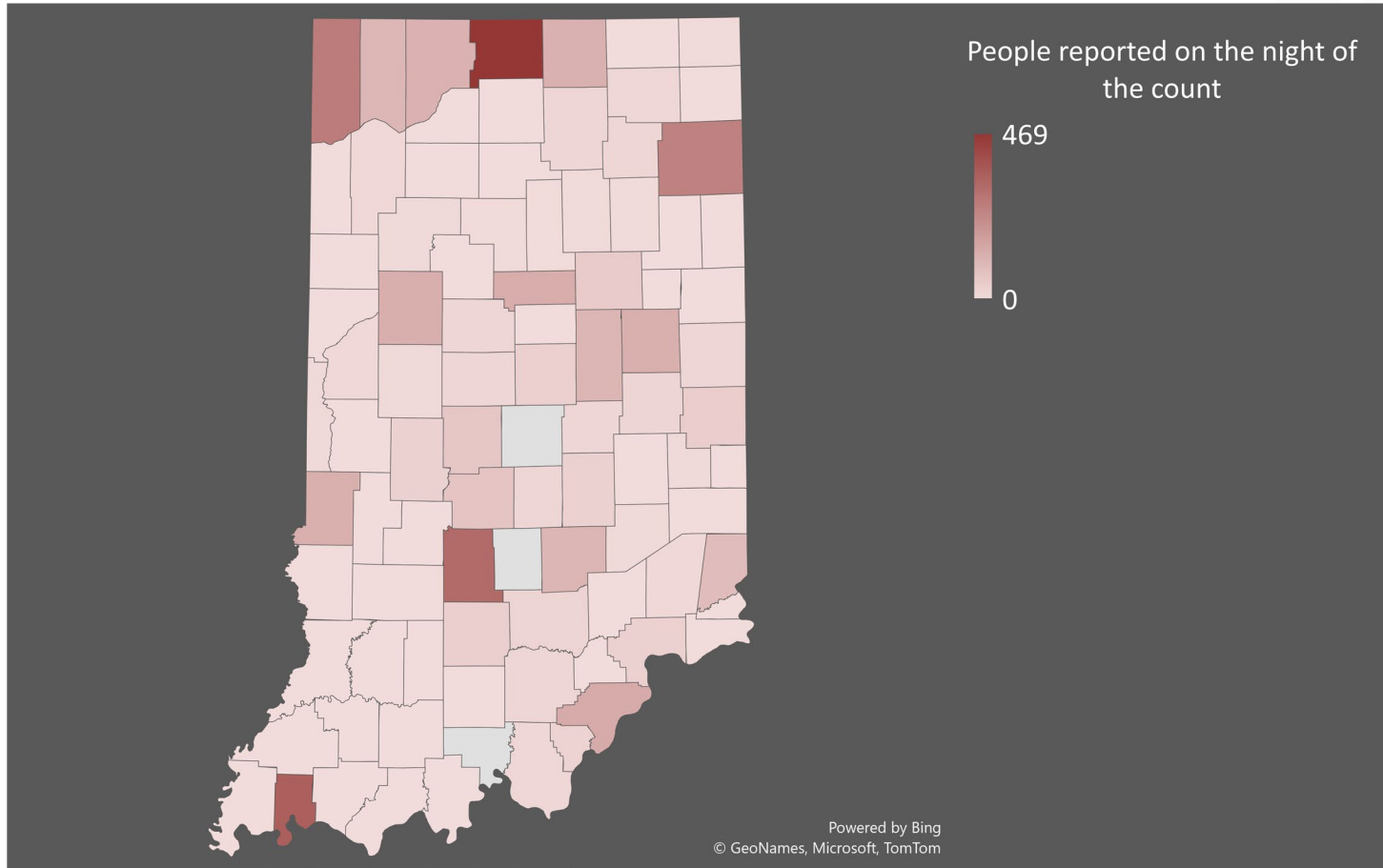
COUNTIES PARTICIPATING IN THE 2022 PIT



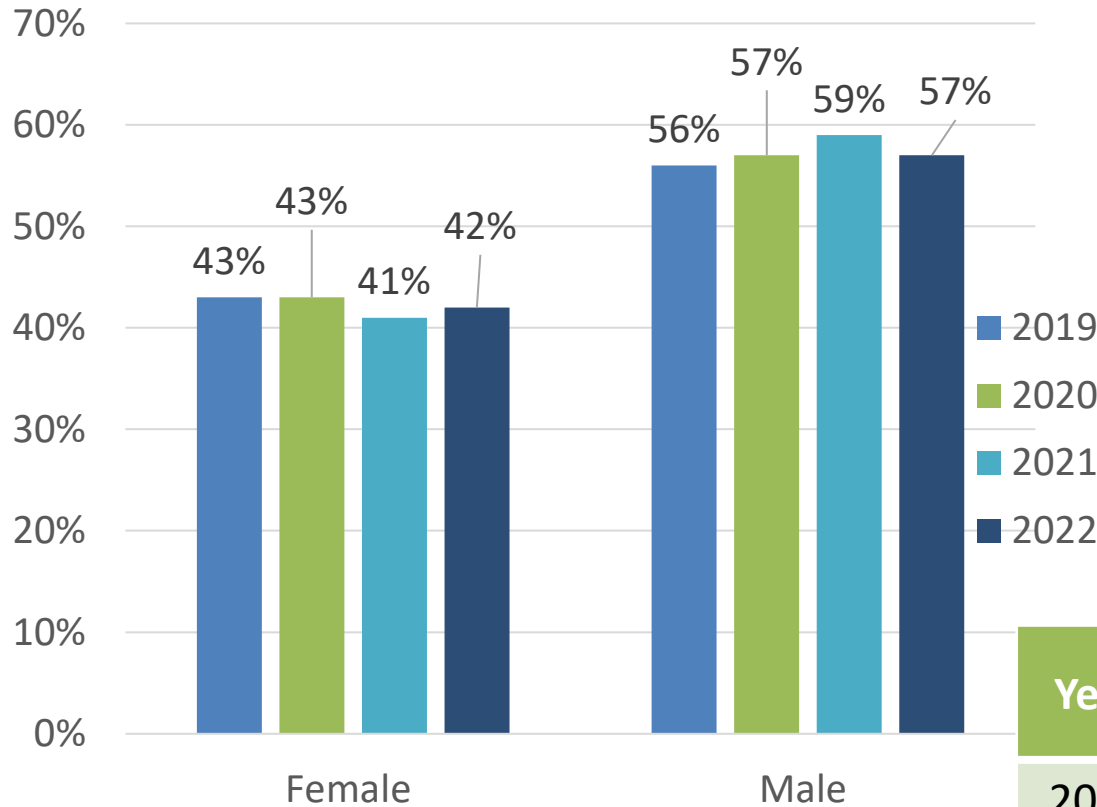
COUNTIES WITH AN UNSHELTERED COUNT

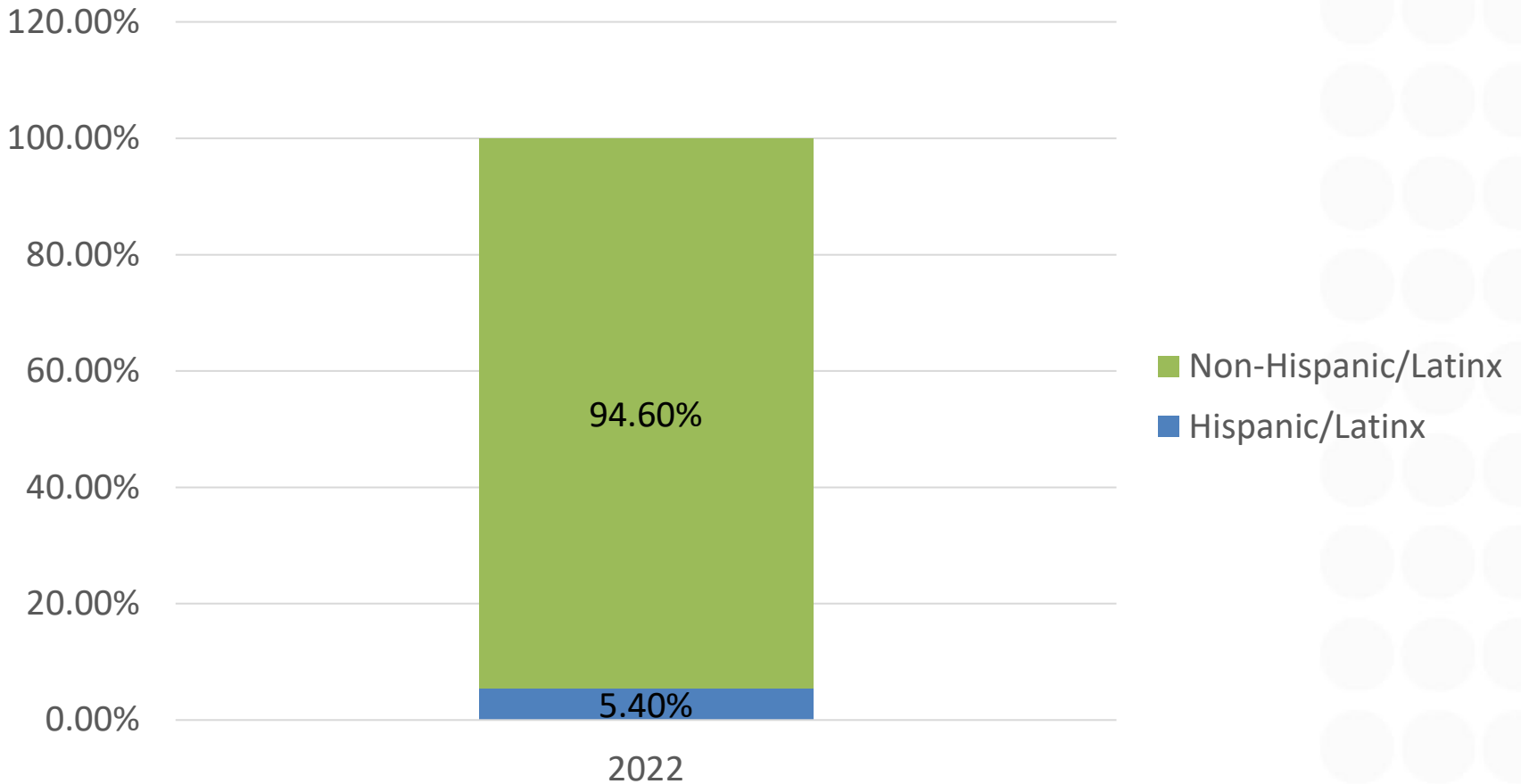
REPORTED GENDER FOR THE TOTAL PIT POPULATION FROM 2019-2022



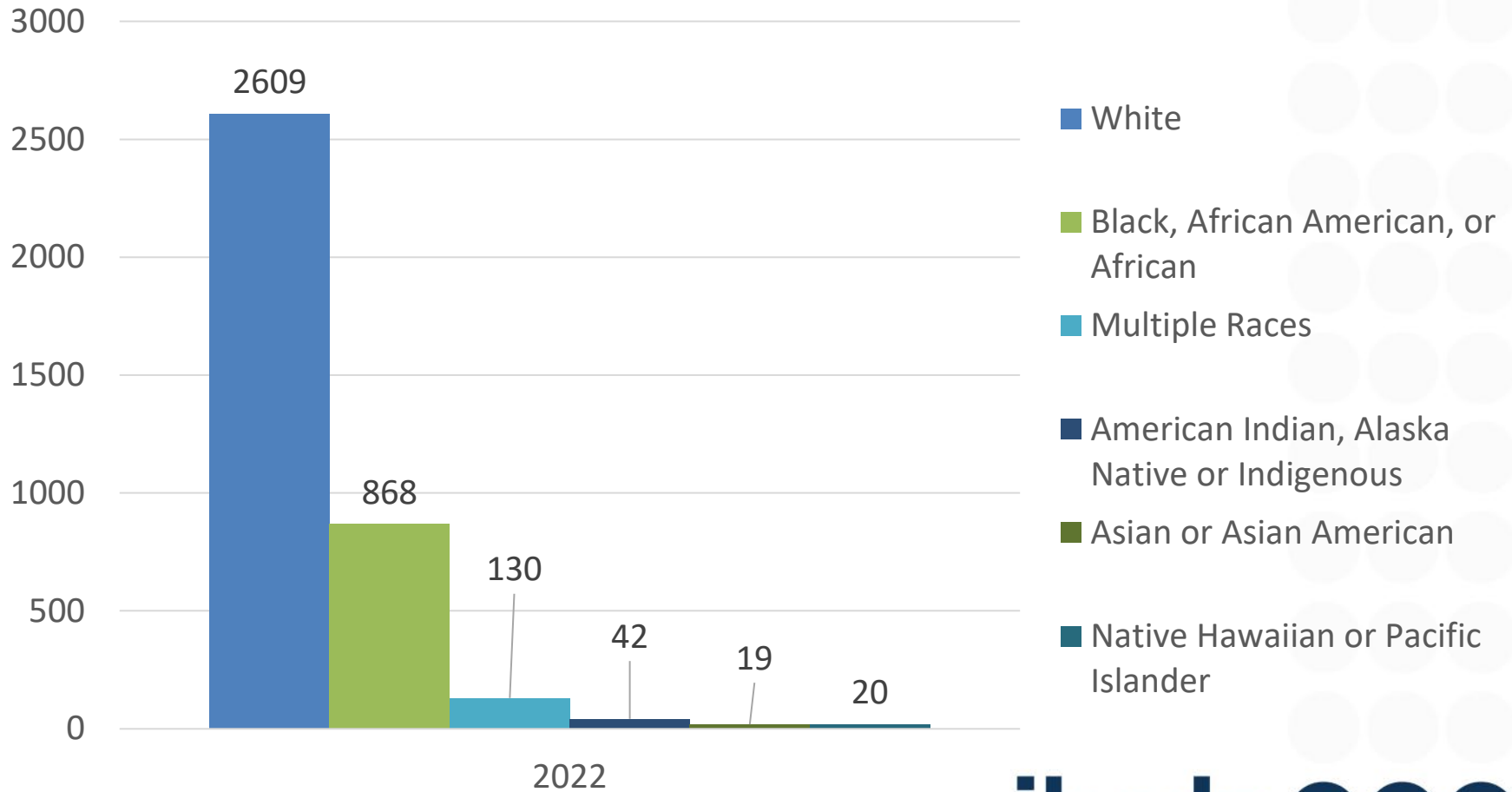

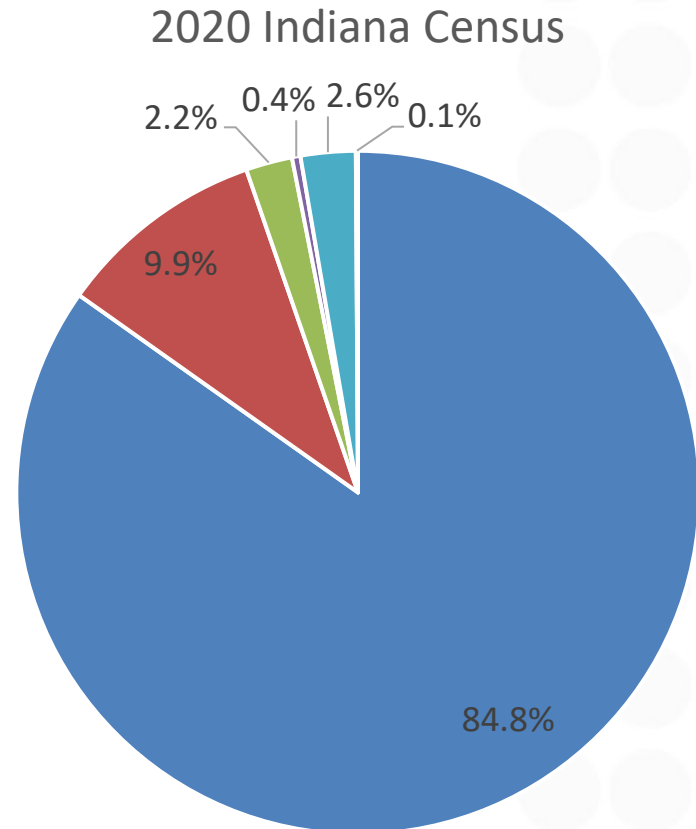
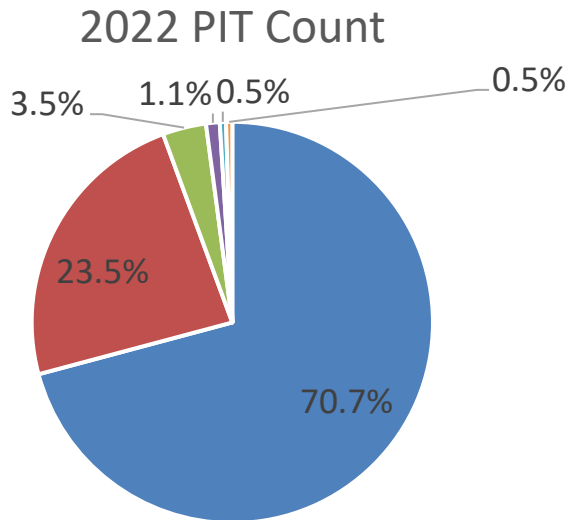
REPORTED ETHNICITY FOR THE TOTAL PIT POPULATION



REPORTED RACE FOR THE TOTAL PIT POPULATION

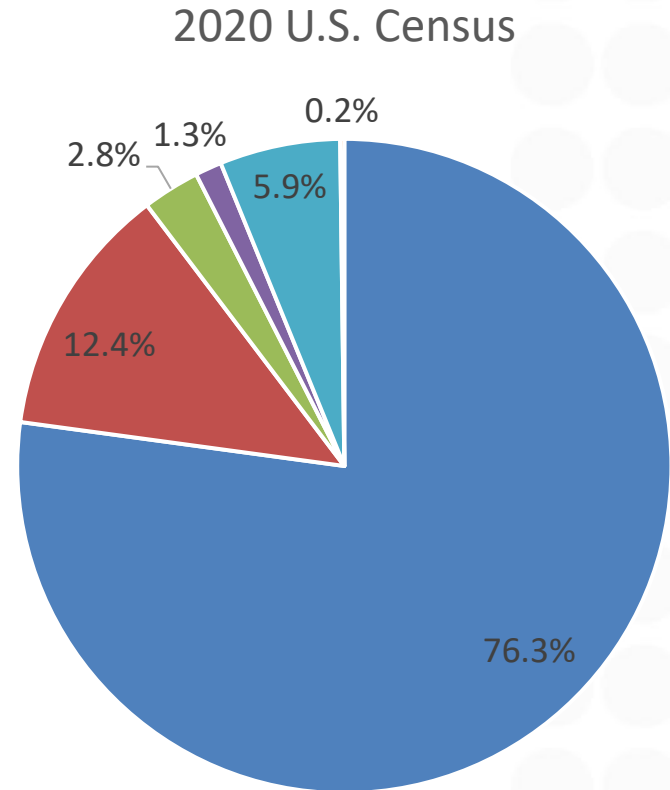
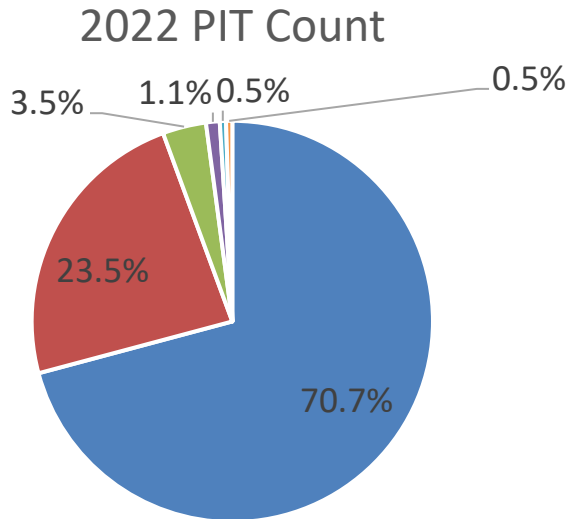


2020 INDIANA CENSUS AND BOS RACE COMPARISON



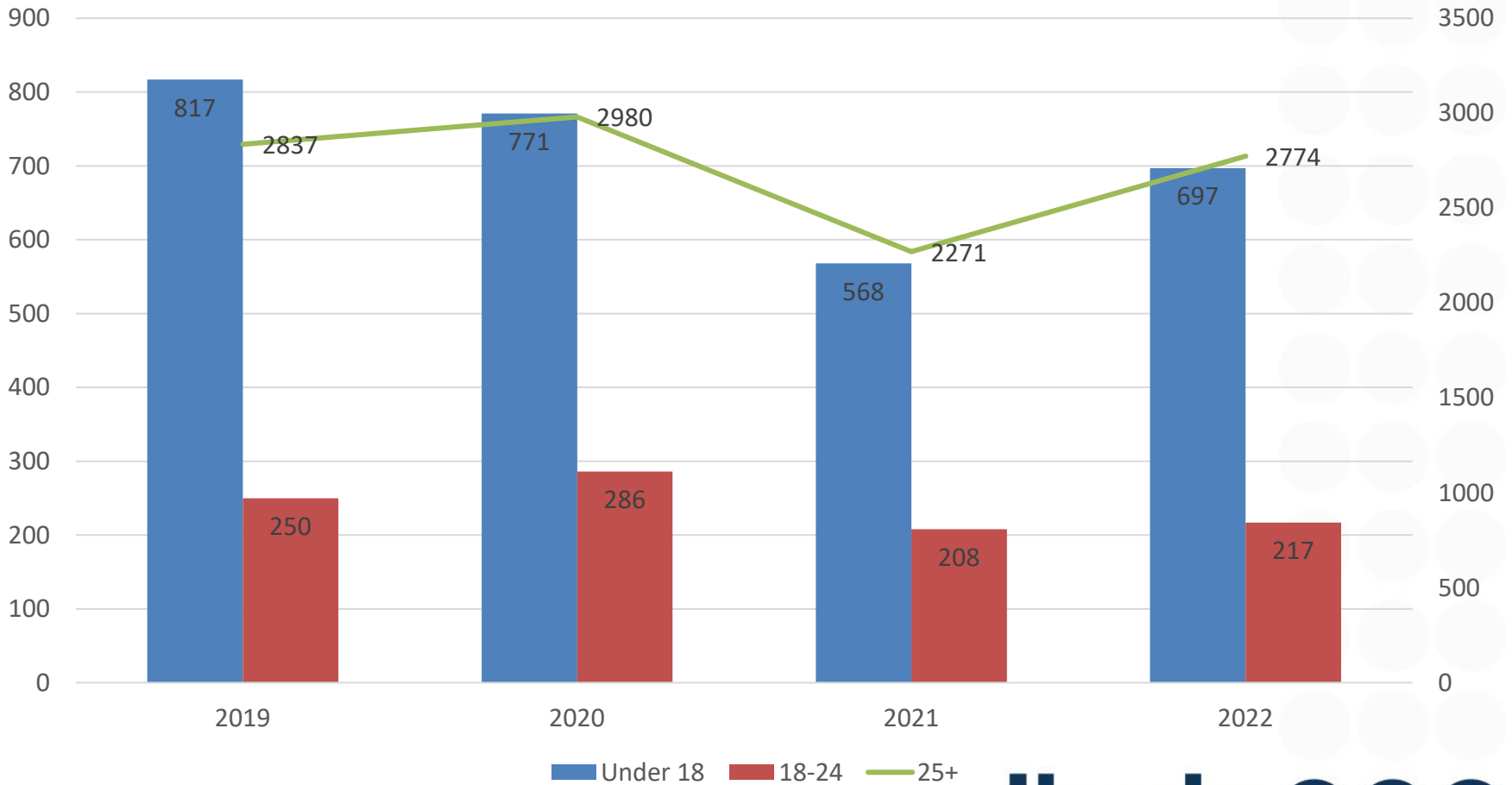

SUMMARY OF RESULTS

- Total PIT BoS numbers increased by 22% for total persons counted, and a 25% increase in total households counted on 1/26/22
- 10% decrease in unsheltered persons counted
- 8.9% of individuals counted were unsheltered
- Preliminary results and corrections before HUD submission prevented undercount
- Over representation of people identifying as black, African American, or African in this year's count compared to 2020 Indiana and United States Census data
- Increase in number of people under 18 by 100+ persons
- 6 out 16 regions decreased their PIT numbers from 2021
