WHAT IS CSBG?

- Federally-funded block grant from the Office of Community Services, Administration for Children and Families, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.
- · Awarded to states, territories and tribes.
- Supports services that alleviate the causes and conditions of poverty nationwide.

WHAT DOES CSBG DO?

Funds services and activities primarily through Community Action Agencies (CAAs) including housing, nutrition, utility, and transportation assistance; employment, education, and other income and asset building services; crisis and emergency services; and community asset building initiatives.

CSBG COMMUNITY IMPACT

In 2021, through CSBG funds...

- 219,462 individuals in 112,059 households were served statewide.
- 1,572 nonprofits and 3,450 for-profit businesses served as partners.
- \$600,000 was issued for COVID-19 Impact Grants to further support the community.
