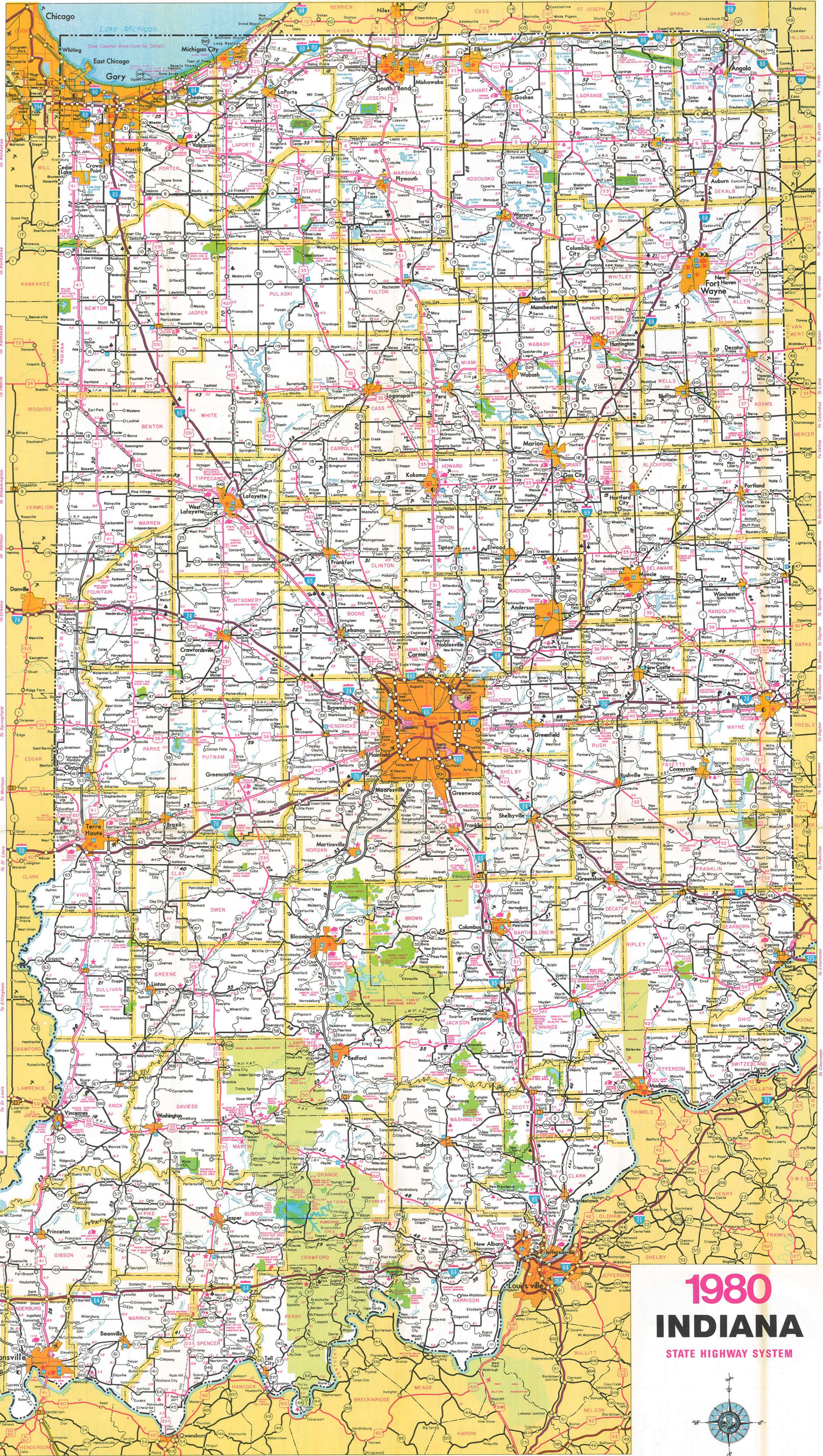

MAP EXPLANATION

- U.S. Routes are shown in red but they are not always the best or shortest routes between points.

AN ACT OF THE INDIANA GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 1961
Chapter 256, which provides that all persons within the jurisdiction of the state shall be entitled to full and equal accommodations, in any place of public accommodation, resort or amusement, without regard to race, religion, or national origin.
MAXIMUM LAWFUL SPEEDS
30 MPH in urban districts, 55 MPH in all other locations (Due to Energy Crisis)
30 MPH in urban districts, 65 MPH in all other locations (Due to Energy Crisis)
Any person who is driving at such high speed and under such circumstances that three or more other vehicles are blocked and cannot pass on the left around the vehicle, shall give right-of-way to such vehicles by pulling off to the right side of the road at the earliest reasonable opportunity and allowing the blocked vehicle to pass.
No vehicle shall pass a school bus stopped on a highway in violation of 2019, except that, passing on the opposite side of a multiple lane highway is permitted, if the lanes are divided by 20 feet or more.
