

I-69 AT SR 14/ILLINOIS ROAD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENT - DES. 1401828 & 1800091



PROJECT DETAILS

With the goal of improving safety and congestion at the I-69 and SR 14/Illinois Road interchange, this project will eliminate weaving movements currently required to transition between corridors. Proposed improvements include the removal of the northeast and southwest loop ramps and realignment of the southeast diagonal ramp to intersect perpendicularly with SR 14/Illinois Road. A new traffic signal is proposed at this new intersection. To accommodate the addition of left-turn movements, the project proposes widening the northwest and southeast exit ramps and removing sections of barrier wall on SR 14. Additionally, this project proposes the extension of loop acceleration lanes to improve merge conditions on I-69.
