## LEGAL NOTICE PLANNED IMPROVEMENT

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) Seymour District has developed preliminary plans for a bridge replacement project near Mount Healthy in Bartholomew County, Indiana. The project is located on State Road (SR) 58 over White Creek, 5.61 miles west of Interstate (I) 65.

The project proposes to replace the SR 58 bridge with a three-span continuous concrete slab bridge and realign SR 58 to the natural stream flow of White Creek. SR 58 will be raised at the bridge. Milling and resurfacing will take place to connect the new pavement to the existing pavement.

The maintenance of traffic plan for this project is to close the road during construction. The official detour will utilize SR 258, I-65, and SR 11. Access to all properties will be maintained throughout construction. Project stakeholders including local school corporation(s) and emergency services will be notified of potential closures and/or detours prior to any construction.

Construction of the project will require approximately 6.93 acres of new permanent right-of-way with an estimated cost of \$4,138,363.00. Federal and state funds are to be utilized for the construction of the project.

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and INDOT have agreed the project falls within the guidelines of a Categorical Exclusion (CE) Level 2 environmental document with no significant impacts on the human and natural environment.
