We have reviewed the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment request you submitted via correspondence dated May 17, 2018. This request adds projects pursuant to changes made to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the:

- Madison County Council of Governments (MCCOG)
- Bloomington/Monroe County Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMCMPO)
- Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization (EMPO)
- Northeastern Indiana Regional Coordinating Council (NIRCC)
