Dear Mr. Brooks:

We have completed our review of INDOT's Amendment #20-56 to the FY 2020-2024 Indiana Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) dated December 20, 2021 and revised on January 27, 2022 due to FHWA's comments. INDOT has re-demonstrated fiscal constraint, air quality conformity, where applicable, and provided opportunity for public comment and involvement on Amendment #20-56. FHWA considers this amendment to be in substantial compliance with the applicable requirements as sufficient to support a consistency finding for the STIP.

FHWA and FTA take formal action, through the development of the Federal Planning Finding (FPF), to evaluate and ensure that the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and MPO Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) are developed according to statewide and metropolitan planning processes consistent with 23 U.S.C. 134 and 135, and 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304, as well as 23 CFR part 450, 500, and 49 CFR part 613. FHWA and FTA are required under 23 CFR 450.220 (b) to document and issue an FPF in conjunction with the approval of the STIP, or amended STIP. Based on the recently conducted FPF (dated November 15, 2021), FHWA and FTA find that the amended Indiana FY2020-2024 STIP substantially meets the transportation planning requirements, and is approving the amended STIP (as recorded in Amendment 20-56) subject to the corrective actions outlined in the FPF. FHWA and FTA will work with INDOT to develop an action plan and timelines to address the corrective actions. If progress is not made in addressing the corrective actions, future amendments to the existing FY2020-2024 STIP, or adoption of the FY2022-2026 STIP, may not be approved by USDOT.

FHWA only recognizes years 2020-2023 in the STIP. Any projects and/or phases of projects added in years outside of 2020-2023 are considered illustrative, and thus ineligible for federal funding at this time.

The Indiana Department of Transportation requests the projects listed in STIP Amendment 20-56 to be incorporated into the 2020-2024 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Any projects and/or phases of projects added in years outside of 2020-2023 are considered illustrative, and thus ineligible for federal funding at this time.

The required Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) documents have been included in this request and duly noted in the Amendment. We have determined that the proposed amendments are: 1) consistent with the transportation plan; 2) the TIP remains fiscally constrained in that federal funding resources are sufficient to support the new or modified projects; and 3) conform to state and national air quality standards.

The total dollar amount of this amendment is \$3,763,469.00 (for fiscal years 2020-2023), has been verified with FHWA.

Section 5. That the FY 2020-24 DMTIP was amended to add Project Des #2100143, Delaware County Bridge Reinspection and Study, for FY 2022 preliminary engineering (PE) costing \$300,000 using \$240,000 in BRZ federal funds and \$60,000 in local match.

Section 6. That the FY 2020-24 DMTIP was amended to add Project Des #2100151, Riverside Avenue resurfacing from Jackson Street to Tillotson Avenue, for FY 2022 preliminary engineering (PE) costing \$300,000 using \$240,000 in STP Urban federal funds and \$60,000 in local match.

Added Travel Lane really refers to the inclusion of an auxiliary center turn lane that will serve as a Two Way Left Turn Lane. The total length of the project is 1.2 miles and the total estimated cost to complete is \$9,357,000. This phase of College Ave is not currently in our 2045 MTP.

For the Blackport Rd Reconstruction and Multi-Use Path from Monroe St to Lincoln Ave, the length of the project is 0.5 miles and the total estimated cost to complete is \$2,730,000. We will be sure to include this information going forward.

- **WHEREAS**, the same proposed DMTIP amendment was reviewed and approved by the Transportation Policy Committee by email vote on August 2-3, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Transportation Policy Committee of the DMMPC as follows:

Section 1. That the FY 2020-24 DMTIP was amended to add Project Des #1802056, US 35 Signs from Richmond to Muncie, for FY 2022 construction (CN) costing \$74,000 using \$59,200 in STBG federal funds and \$14,800 in state match.

Section 2. That the FY 2020-24 DMTIP was amended to add Project Des #2000582, SR 32 HMA Overlay from US 35 to the east 3.93 miles, for FY 2023 construction (CN) costing \$3,351,375 using \$2,681,100 in NHPP federal funds and \$670,275 in state match.

Section 3. That the FY 2020-24 DMTIP was amended to add Project Des #2000594, SR 332 HMA Overlay from I-69 to the east 7.65 miles, for FY 2022 right-of-way acquisition (RW) costing \$15,000 using \$12,000 in STBG federal funds and \$3,000 in state match.

Section 4. That the FY 2020-24 DMTIP was amended to add Project Des #2001161, SR 32 HMA Overlay from Perdieu Road to US 35, for FY 2023 construction (CN) costing \$6,522,499 using \$5,217,999 in STBG federal funds and \$1,304,500 in state match.

Section 5. That the FY 2020-24 DMTIP was amended to add Project Des #2100287, Statewide Highway/Rail Grade Crossing Safety Action Plan, for FY 2022 preliminary engineering (PE) costing \$7,130 using \$6,430 in HSIP federal funds and \$700 in state match.

Section 6. That the FY 2020-24 DMTIP was amended for Project Des #1900147, US 35 at CR 300S intersection, to add FY 2022 right-of-way acquisition (RW) costing \$35,000 using \$28,000 in STBG federal funds and \$7,000 in state match.

Section 7. That the FY 2020-24 DMTIP was amended for Project Des #1900151, SR 32 at Nebo safety improvements, to add FY 2022 right-of-way acquisition (RW) costing \$20,000 using \$16,000 in STBG federal funds and \$4,000 in state match.
