Hi Larry,

Attached is NIRPC Administrative Amendment No. 16 for the Porter County Aging and Community Services (PCACS). The amendment splits the FY 2014 funding for the extended hours of operation New Freedom project in Porter County. With the changes in MAP-21, New Freedom no longer exists. NIRPC had just over \$139,000 left of New Freedom funds to spend. This amount covered most of the two New Freedom projects, but not all. Consequently, NIRPC is modifying the TIP to reflect two funding sources for PCACS for FY 2014.
