Doing Business With INDOT as a Consultant

- Things to be aware of:

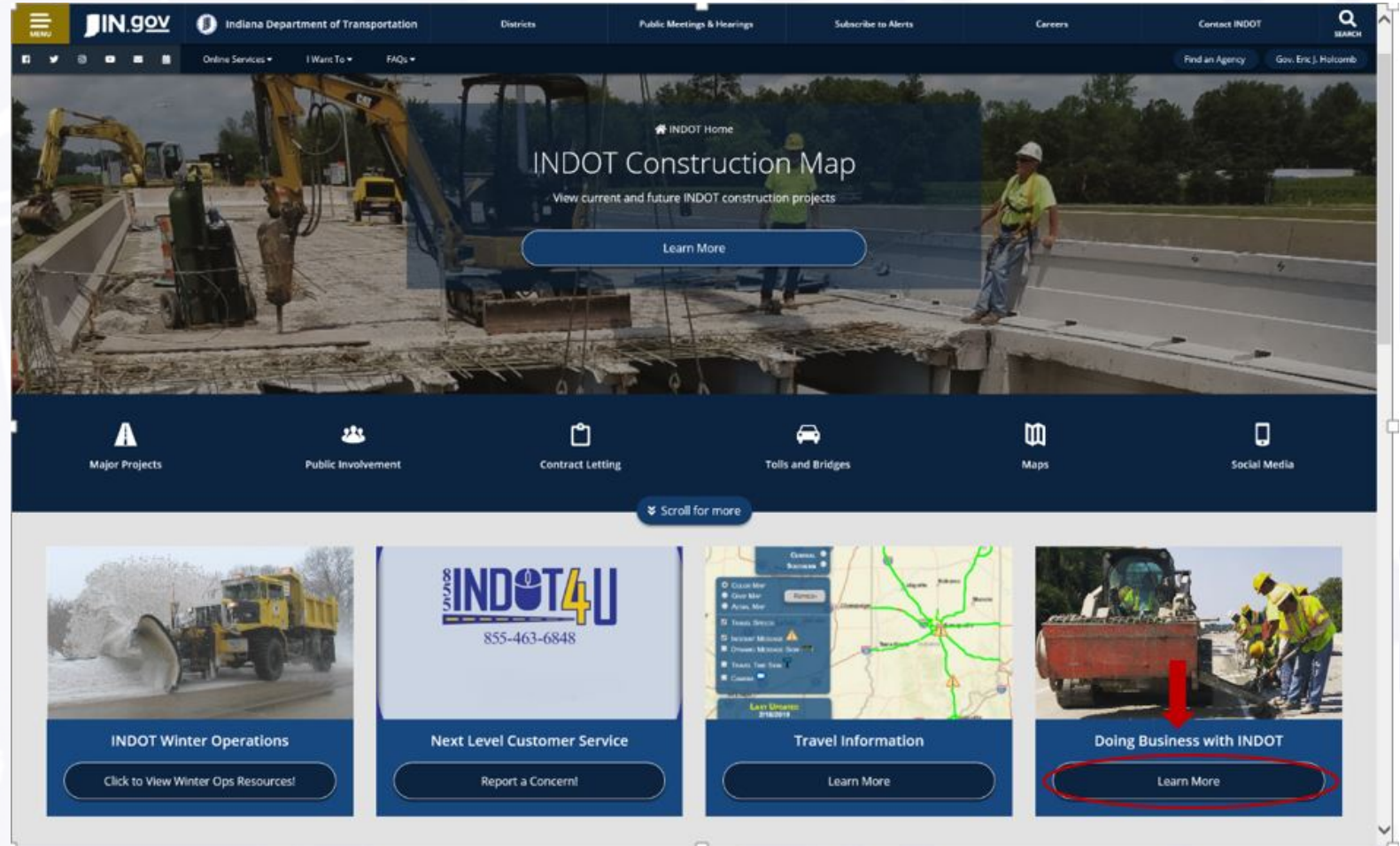
1. It is not a low-bid environment but is qualifications-based.
2. With few exceptions, which are listed on the Prequalification page, all consultants providing services to INDOT must be prequalified. This is also qualification-based, not monetary.
3. You must be registered in the Professional Services Contracting System (PSCS) as all Letters of Interest (LOIs) must be submitted through that system, as well as the prequalification application.

- Therefore, be certain you are registered in PSCS and properly prequalified before attempting to submit a bid on a project.

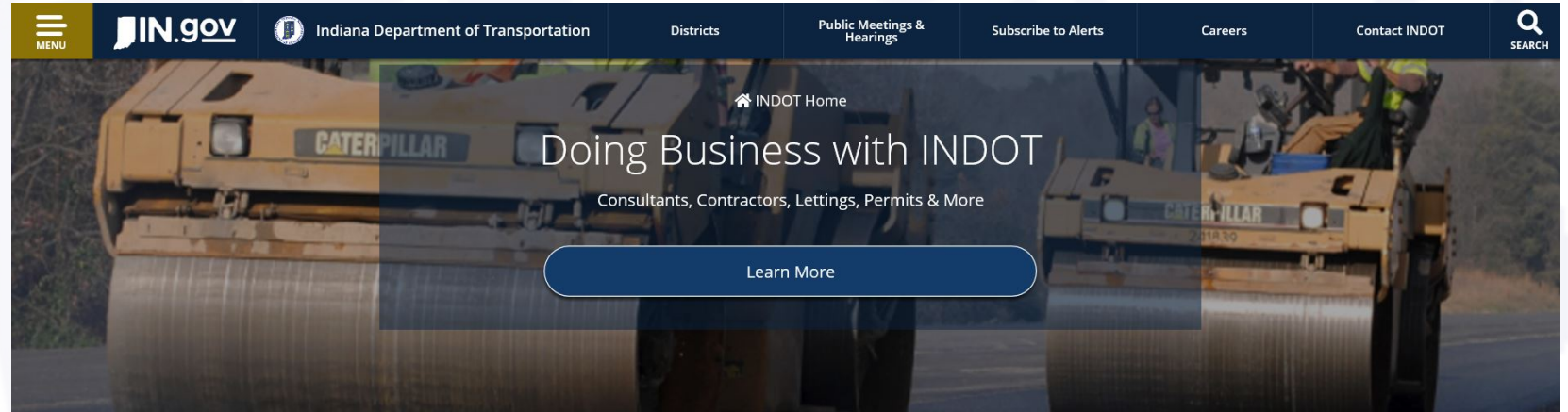


