INDIANA GRAIN INDEMNITY BOARD GC OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Hawkins reviewed appointments of Board Members that were slated for 2013. Indiana Bankers Association reappointed Joseph Kessie for an additional 4 year term. Indiana Farm Bureau appointed Randy Kron to fill the seat of Herman Rettinger, who is retiring from the Board. Chairman Hawkins congratulated Joe & Randy. He also wanted to thank Herman for his many years of service to the Board and the producers of Indiana. H. Rettinger had been on the Board since it's inception.

MINUTES: Chairman Hawkins stated that the minutes from the November 01, 2012 meeting had been previously distributed to the board members and asked if there were any changes. B. Tudor moved that the

minutes of the November 01, 2012 meeting be approved as written. (Second by J. Kessie) *Motion was carried to approve the minutes as written from the November 01, 2012 meeting.*

FINANCIAL: Financial statements and investment listing had previously been distributed to the board. V. Pool stated that as of June 30, 2013 the fund balance was \$14,017,119.94. M. Silver motioned to accept the financials as written and to certify the funds as of July 1, 2013 to be \$14,017,119.94, (Second by G. Whaley) *Motion was carried to accept the financials as written and to certify the fund at \$14,017,119.94 as of July 1, 2013.*

NEW BUSINESS: At this time W. Tudor introduced J. Benham, President of Farmers Union. Bill gave history on his background and work on the board.

Chairman Hawkins reminded the board that the offices of Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer are to be voted on at this annual meeting. He also stated that per statute the office of Secretary and Treasurer may be combined and have one person serve both offices. Chairman Hawkins then asked for nominations from the floor. B. Tudor motioned that D. Villwock remain as Vice Chairman and M. Shuter remain as Secretary/Treasurer. (Second by B. Bischoff) Chairman Hawkins then asked if there were any additional nominations and there were none. *The motion to elect D. Villwock as Vice Chairman and M. Shuter as Secretary/Treasurer was carried by a unanimous vote.*

Chairman Hawkins shared with the board that the Agency has been working with Co-Alliance, LLP regarding the recent explosion at one of their facilities. He also mentioned that the Agency has an open auditor position with the departure of the auditor in Southern Indiana.

J. Kessie asked that the board to consider possible statutory changes regarding licensing requirements for IGBWLA. After much discussion, M. Silver suggested that the Chairman appoint members to a study group. Chairman Hawkins suggested a possible date for the study group to meet on September 4, 2013 at the IGBWLA Office.

OLD BUSINESS: Chairman Hawkins noted that H. Crocket from the Attorney General's Office could not make today's meeting, but he had updates on the outstanding litigation. J. Hawkins gave a brief update on the promissory note that was assigned over to the board during the Lambright's, Inc. failure. M. Light also noted that the board has 1st priority. Then he discussed with the Board the proceedings in the Bill Wohead/Mentone Agri Center litigation. M. Light gave an update regarding the timeline regarding this litigation.

ADJOURNMENT: It was motioned that the meeting adjourn by D. Villwock. (Second by R. Reichart) The meeting adjourned at 11:15 a.m.
