QUORUM: Chairman Hawkins did a roll call of the Board members and confirmed that there was a quorum present. Chairman Hawkins stated that to meet statutory requirements, this is the second meeting scheduled for year.

MINUTES: Copies of the minutes of the previous meeting (July 18, 2013) were forwarded to board members to review. W. Tudor moved to approve the minutes as written. (Second from R. Kron) *The motion was carried and the minutes of the July 18, 2013 meeting were approved as written.*

FINANCIAL: Financial statements and investment listings had previously been distributed to the board. Chairman Hawkins asked the board to review and any questions to be directed to V. Pool, representative for the Office of the Treasurer of State. The Board had no questions for V. Pool. Balance of the fund as of October 31, 2013 was \$14,022,683.99.

NEW BUSINESS: Chairman Hawkins reported to the board that the Agency does have some licensees that the Agency is concerned and dealing with. He also reported that the Agency hired a new auditor that will be based in Daviess County, Daniel Wilkins.

Chairman Hawkins reported to the board that the Agency is scheduled to host the 2015 Annual Conference for the Association of Grain Regulatory Officials.

OLD BUSINESS: J. Kessie reported that the legislative committee appointed by the Chairman had met and reported their recommendations to the board. After much discussion, D. Villwock motioned that the board support the recommendation of increasing licensees net worth minimums from \$10,000.00 to \$50.000.00. (Second by R. Kron) *The motion was carried and the recommendation from the legislative committee to support IGBWLA legislation changes to licensee's minimum net worth is increased to \$50,000.00.*

A second motion was made by R. Kron to table legislative recommendations to the indemnity program statute. (Second by B. Bischoff) *The motion to table legislative recommendations to the indemnity program statute until the next meeting was carried.*

Matt Light reported that Heather Crockett is handling the legal items could not make the meeting. The two outstanding items were addressed. Concerning the legal matter of Mentone Agri Center, LLC, the depositions have been pushed back & the court date to April 14, 2014.

The board reviewed their schedules and agreed to meet on July 22, 2014 for the next Annual Meeting at Farm Bureau.

ADJOURNMENT: It was motioned that the meeting adjourn by M. Silver. (Second by R. Kron) The meeting adjourned at 11:10 a.m.
