### **Opportunity for Public Comment on CenterPoint Energy Indiana South's CPCN Case**

- WHAT:** The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) will hold a field hearing in Evansville to hear from the public on the certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) petition of CenterPoint Energy Indiana South (previously called Vectren South) under [Cause No. 45564](#).
- WHEN:** October 13, 2021, at 6 p.m. local time
- WHERE:** Old National Events Plaza – Locust Rooms, 715 Locust Street, Evansville, IN 47708
- WHY:** CenterPoint Energy Indiana South has filed a petition before the Commission requesting the issuance of a CPCN for the construction of two combined cycle gas turbine generation facilities and other related cost recovery.
- HOW:** During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the Commissioners and Judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case.
