The utility is proposing to eliminate its Stewartsville Area surcharge (\$16.61) and eliminate Marrs Township Service Area Rates. These changes are requested as a result of the early retirement of the German Township Water District's debt. All customers will now pay

the Original System rates.

The Stewartsville Area customers will receive a flat \$16.61 per month rate reduction. A Marrs Township Service Area customer using 5,000 gallons will see a \$28.18 monthly cost reduction (from

\$49.68 to \$21.50)
