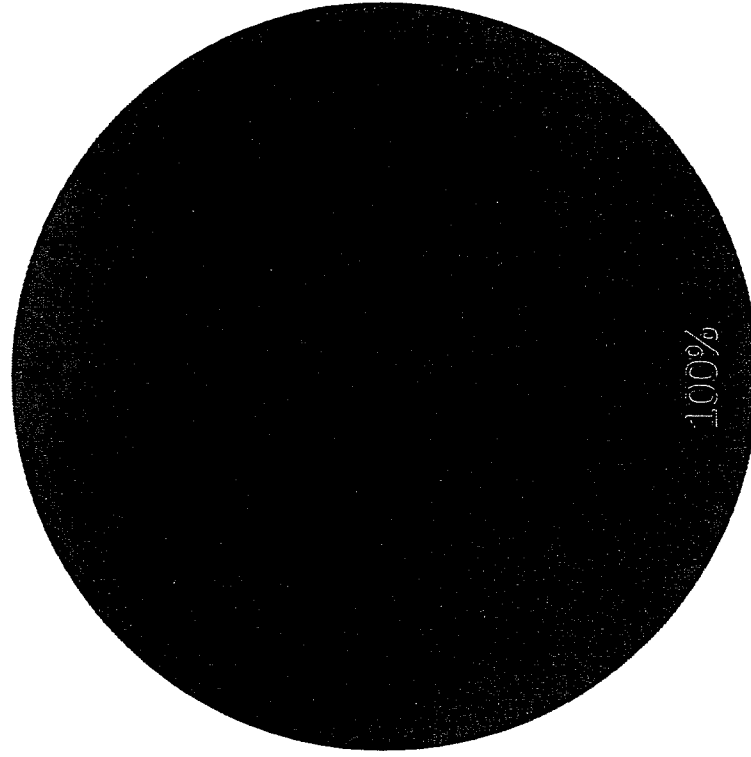

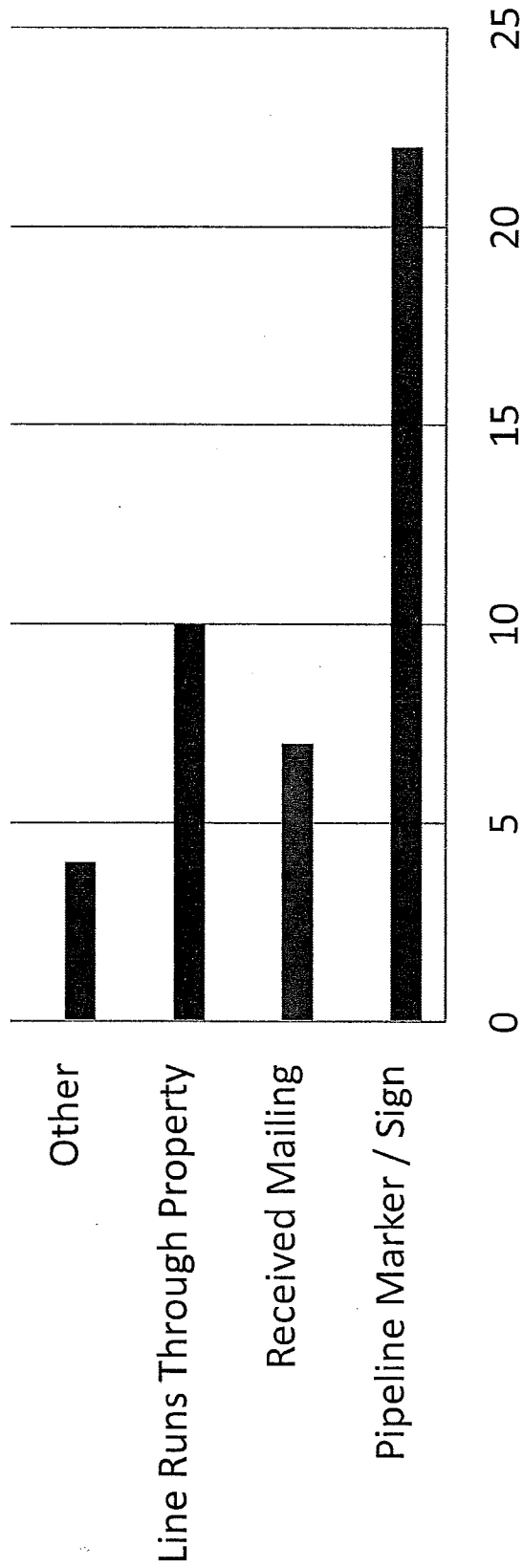
Do you know how to recognize a pipeline right-of-way?

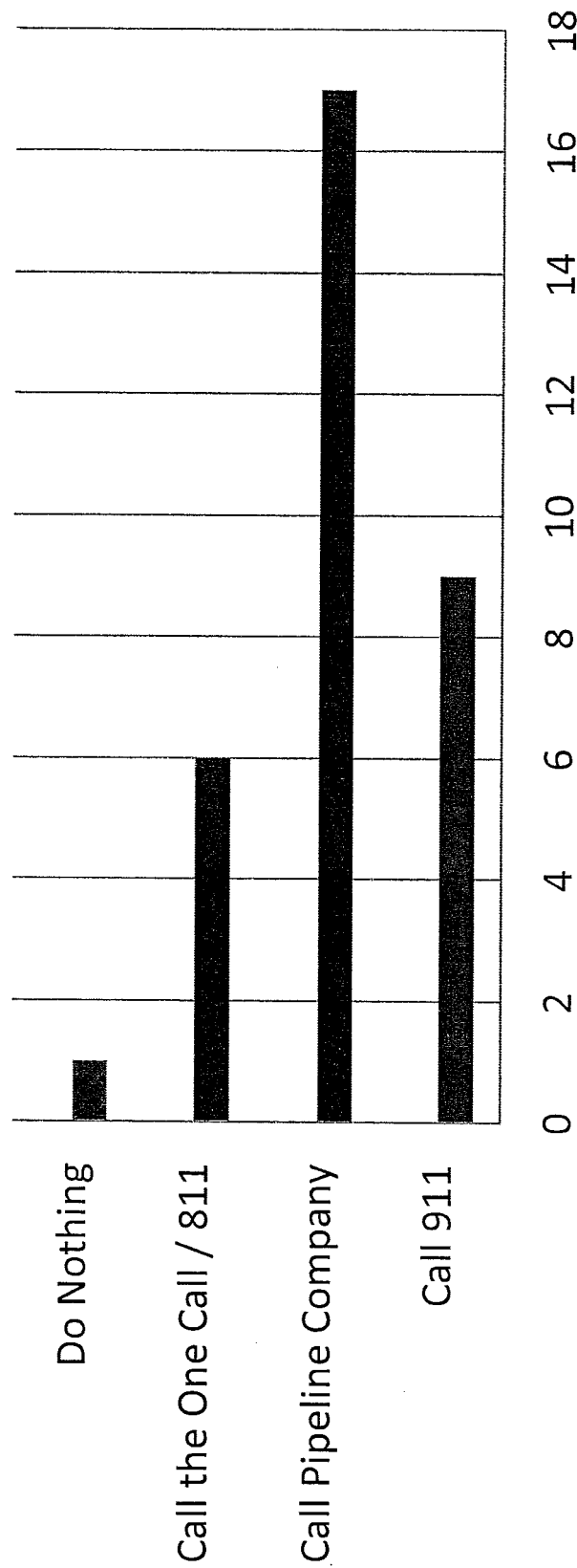

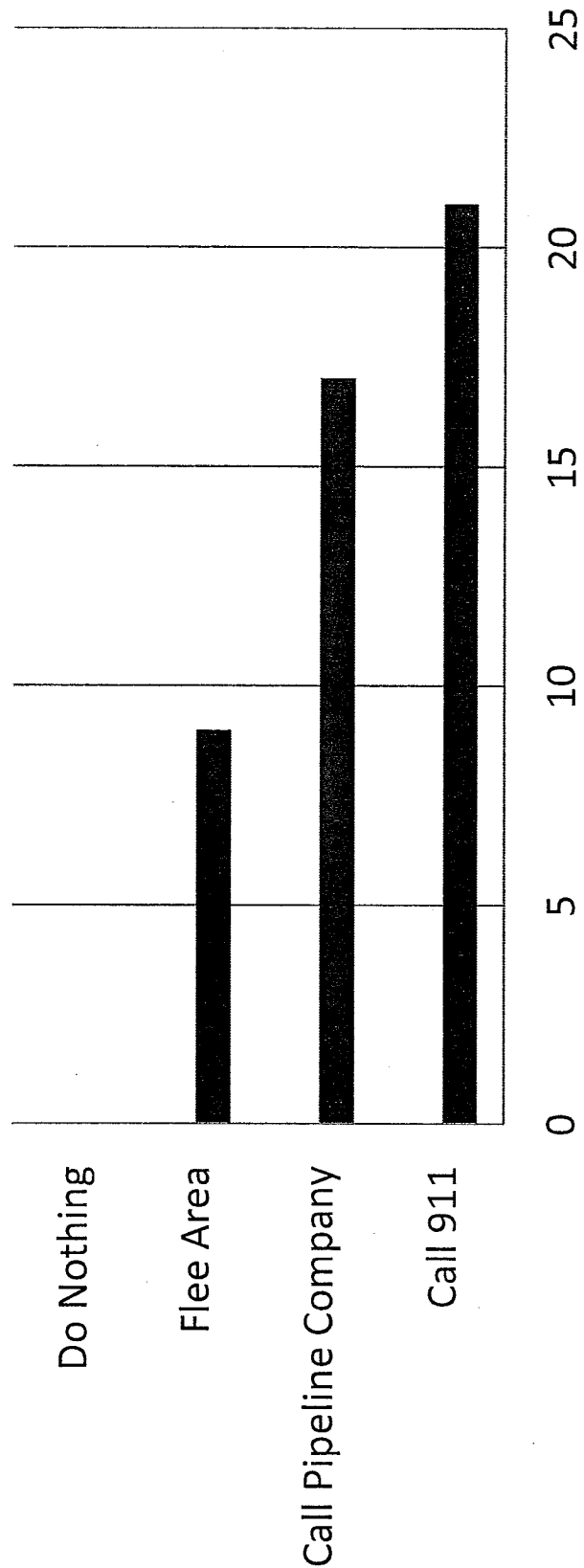

What would you likely do if you saw suspicious or construction related activity on or near a pipeline right-of-way?



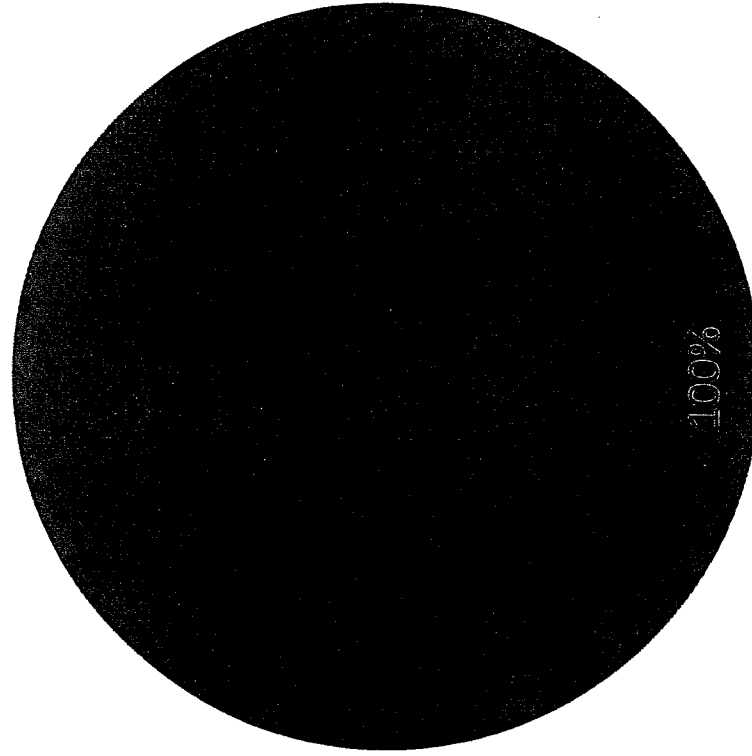

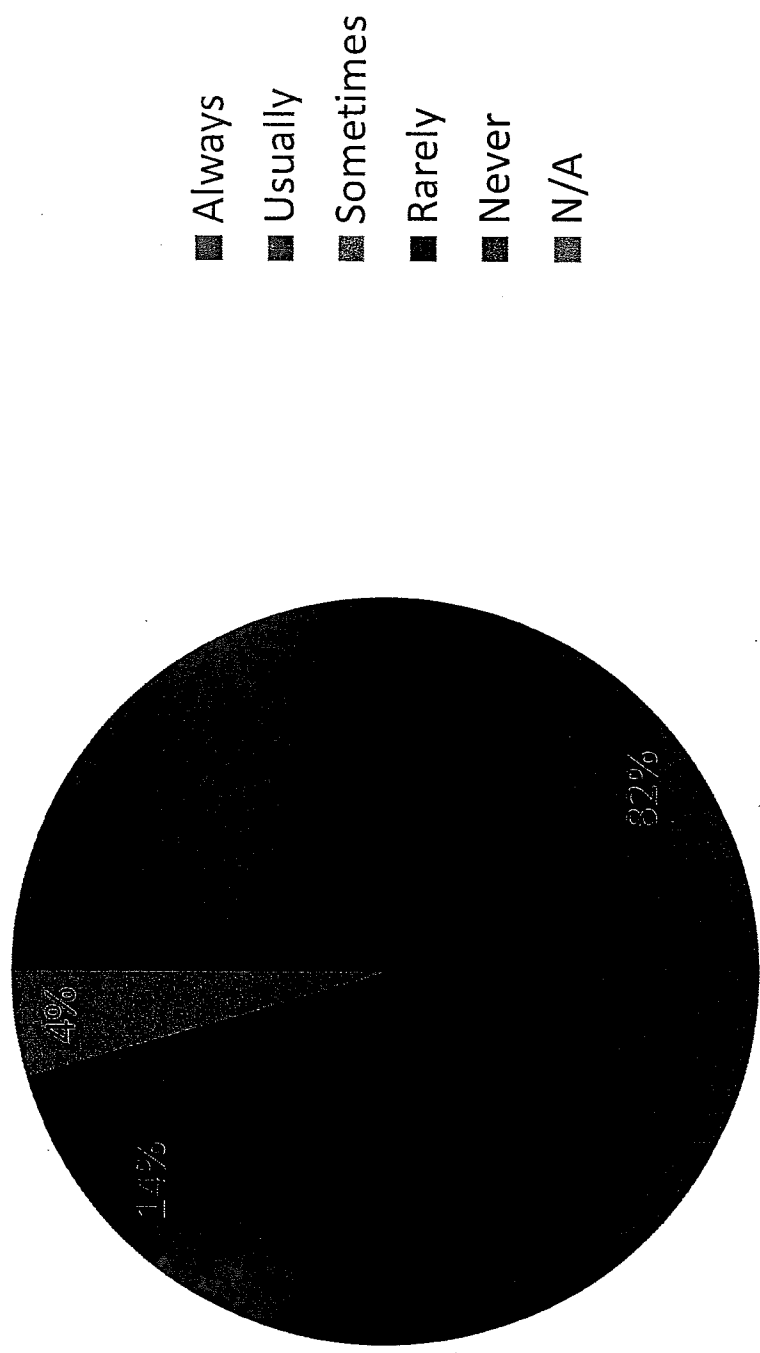

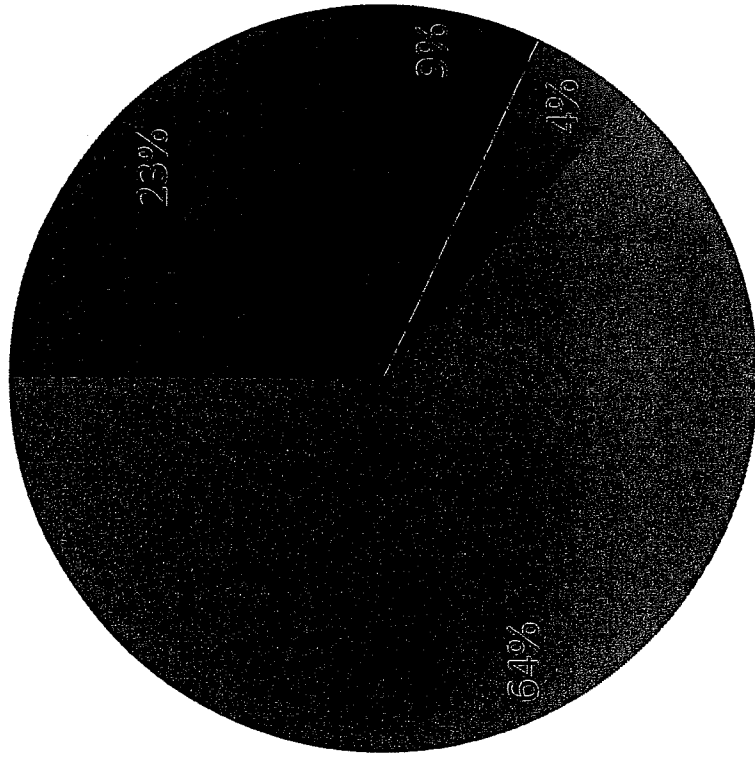
