**Staff Recommendations:** Requirements in 170 IAC 1-6 and Cause No. 44004 were met. Staff believes applicable FCC requirements were met, as well. Pursuant to IC 8-1-32.5-11(c), all communications service tariffs filed after June 30, 2021, become effective upon filing. Therefore, this filing became *effective* July 15, consistent with both state and federal law.<sup>3</sup> However, the Commission must still review all intrastate access charges for reasonableness.<sup>4</sup> **Staff believes the proposed changes are reasonable and recommends final approval.**

AdamsWells’ CTA is statewide, except for the Craigville Telephone Company, Inc. ILEC service territory. Customers seeking to purchase intrastate access services in Craigville’s ILEC territory will need to purchase those services separately. The Craigville ILEC is currently listed as a concurring carrier in the intrastate access tariff of Rochester Telephone Company (“Rochester”). Title Sheet 1 of the instant tariff explains the respective territories of the Craigville ILEC and CLEC entities, and includes a citation to the Rochester tariff.
