ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

Request:

NIPSCO requests to revise its IURC Gas Service Tariff, Original Volume No. 7. NIPSCO proposes to combine the current five nomination and transportation zones A, B, C, D, and E into three nomination transportation zones A (formerly zones A&D), B (formerly zones B&C), and E.

Customer Impact:

NIPSCO's proposal will not change the gas rates paid by customers. The consolidation of transportation nomination zones will reduce the number of pools and contracts that suppliers have for pooling transportation. The consolidation results in Zones C and D being eliminated.

Zone D has two transportation pools; whereas, Zone C has no transportation pools. The reduction in the number of pools in Zone D will reduce the pooling fees collected from Pool Operators. The annual savings by the Pool Operators would be approximately \$9,000.
