*In lieu of using the standard water tracking procedure, the rates applicable to Georgetown and Floyd's Knobs have been recalculated pursuant to the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement approved in Cause Numbers 42042 and 43413. The monthly capital charge for Georgetown will decrease by \$105 to \$2,884 from the previous charge of \$2,989. The monthly capital charge for Floyd's Knobs will decrease by \$34 to \$6,715 from the previous charge of \$6,749. The rates applicable to Edwardsville have been calculated pursuant to the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement approved in Cause No. 43325. The meter charge for Edwardsville will decrease by \$258.96 to \$324.47 from the previous charge of \$583.43.
