ANNUAL REPORT OF THE PUBLIC ACCESS COUNSELOR To the Indiana General Assembly

July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005

Pursuant to Indiana Code section 5-14-4-12, this is the annual report of the activities of the Office of the Public Access Counselor (Office) for the time period covering July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. PART II Executive Summary

Public Access Counselor and Staff Counsel

The Office of the Public Access Counselor is staffed by two attorneys: the Public Access Counselor and a staff attorney. Early in this reporting period, on July 6, 2004, Karen Davis was appointed Public Access Counselor by former Governor Joseph Kernan. Karen Davis was appointed to fill the remainder of the four-year term of office beginning July 1, 2003 and ending June 30, 2007.

The Office of the Public Access Counselor employed staff attorney Lea Ellingwood until February 4, 2005. The current staff attorney is April Schultheis. She began her duties in the Office on May 2, 2005.

Advisory Opinions

From July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005, the Office issued 219 written advisory opinions on formal complaints. Twenty opinions are pending as of June 30, 2005. Under Indiana Code 5-14-5-9 and 10, advisory opinions must be issued within either seven (7) or thirty (30) days of receipt of a formal complaint. The former deadline is for priority complaints (62 IAC 1). The Office met the statutory requirements for issuance of advisory opinions. A detailed list of advisory opinions and a brief description of the opinions follow in Appendix B, below.

Education and Presentations

The Public Access Counselor made thirty-four educational presentations for various groups over the past year. This is an increase of ten presentations over the previous reporting period. The Public Access Counselor has generally given presentations upon invitation. In the future, the Office will target some of its training efforts to groups that have not contacted the Office for training.

Handbook and Other Educational Materials

The Public Access Handbook was most recently revised effective December 2003, and it is posted on the Office's website, www.IN.gov/pac. The Office receives many requests for the print version of the handbook. This year, the Office gave permission to the Hoosier State Press Association and the Indiana Coalition for Open Government to print the Handbook at the expense of those organizations. The Office also placed a print order, but its supply is limited by budgetary constraints. In order to save cost to the Office, the Office encourages persons to download the Handbook from the web for free. The Office plans to update the Handbook to reflect changes in the

access laws enacted in 2005.

Oversight Committee on Public Records

Effective July 1, 2001, the Public Access Counselor serves as a member of the Oversight Committee on Public Records, the governing body for the Indiana Commission on Public Records. The Committee generally meets one time each month. During the first half of the reporting period, the Public Access Counselor served as Chair of the Committee.
