# ANNUAL REPORT OF THE INDIANA PUBLIC ACCESS COUNSELOR To the Indiana General Assembly

July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012

Pursuant to Ind. Code § 5-14-4-12, the Indiana Public Access Counselor ("PAC") hereby submits this annual report of activities for the time period covering July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. This report is presented in three parts: in Part I a narrative summary of the activities of the PAC; in Part II the information required to be submitted pursuant to I.C. § 5-14-4-12; and in Part III appendices listing presentations given and advisory opinions issued in the past year.

# PART I Annual Report Narrative

#### **Public Access Counselor and Staff**

On July 1, 2011, Governor Daniels appointed Public Access Counselor Andrew J. Kossack to a four-year term of office ending June 30, 2015. On July 8, 2011, Counselor Kossack resigned to accept a position with the Indiana Department of Education. Subsequently, Governor Daniels appointed Joseph B. Hoage to serve as Public Access Counselor for the balance of the term. Counselor Hoage took office on July 10, 2011. The PAC also employs one part-time legal assistant, with the position currently being open at this time.

#### **Advisory Opinions**

From July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012, the PAC issued 297 written advisory opinions in response to formal complaints. *See* I.C. 5-14-5 regarding the complaint process. Twenty-one (21) complaints were pending as of June 30, 2012. Pursuant to I.C. § 5-14-5-9, an advisory opinion must be issued within thirty days of receipt of a formal complaint. The deadline for priority complaints is seven days. *See* I.C. § 5-14-5-10; 62 IAC 1. The PAC met the statutory requirement for timely issuance of advisory opinions. See Appendix B for a detailed list.

#### **Informal Opinions**

In addition to advisory opinions in response to formal complaints, the PAC issues written informal opinions pursuant to I.C. § 5-14-4-10(5). The PAC issued sixty-three (63) informal opinions for the period July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012.

#### **Telephone and Electronic Mail Inquiries**

From July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012, the two PAC staff members received and responded to 1580 inquiries via telephone and electronic mail.

#### **Education and Presentations**

The Public Access Counselor made thirty-five (35) educational presentations in FY 2012, as compared to the eighteen (18) presentations given in FY 2011. Appendix A contains a list of the presentations.

#### **Handbook and Other Educational Materials**

The *Public Access Handbook* was revised in FY 2012 and is expected to be received from the printer in August 2012. The *Handbook* is issued by the PAC and the Office of the Attorney General pursuant to I.C. § 5-14-4-10(3). The PAC would like to thank Steve Key and the Hoosier State Press Association for all of their assistance in the production of the *Handbook*. The *Handbook* is a resource utilized by many public officials and the public at large, and the PAC receives many requests for the print version of the *Handbook*. The *Handbook* is posted on the PAC's website, <a href="https://www.IN.gov/pac">www.IN.gov/pac</a>, and the PAC encourages individuals and agencies to download it from the website at no charge. While there is still strong demand for a paper version of the *Handbook*, the PAC budget does not allow printing of bound copies of the *Handbook* (the PAC will, of course, print a copy pursuant to a request for access to records and charge the requester \$.10 per page for the copy).

In addition to the *Handbook*, the PAC has continued to create new resources and make those available via the PAC website. The Counselor also prepared slides and handouts for participants at the educational seminars to which the Counselor was invited. Because the PAC budget will not allow the PAC to provide copies of slides and handouts to attendees at all events (some of which number in the hundreds), the PAC generally asks the sponsoring organization to provide copies for attendees. The PAC makes copies of all slide presentations available via the PAC website.

#### **Public Access Counselor Website**

The Office of the Public Access Counselor maintains a website at <a href="www.in.gov/pac">www.in.gov/pac</a>. The website contains more than formal advisory opinions and ---informal opinions that have been issued since 1998. In addition to the resources listed in previous paragraphs, the website contains upcoming and past presentations of the PAC, sample letters and meeting notices, frequently asked questions, previous year's Annual Reports, and other resources.

#### **Oversight Committee on Public Records**

Pursuant to I.C. § 5-15-5.1-18, the Public Access Counselor serves as a member of the Oversight Committee on Public Records, the governing body for the Indiana Commission on Public Records.
