PART II Executive Summary

Staff Attorney

In late June, 1999, Rebecca K. Browning began work as the staff attorney for the Office. Ms. Browning currently works 40-45 hours per week assisting the Public Access Counselor by handling inquiries and complaints and making presentations on the state's public access laws around the state. In addition to these duties, Ms. Browning has worked on revisions to existing publications and the development of additional educational materials for the public and public officials.

Administrative rule

As required in Indiana Code section 5-14-5-10(b), an administrative rule was adopted and became effective June 25, 2000 to set the priorities for dealing with formal complaints. The rule can be found at 62 IAC 1.

Advisory Opinions

Since July 1, 1999, the Office has issued 41 written advisory opinions and three (3) remain pending. Written advisory opinions have been issued within the thirty (30) day period in all but one case. A more detailed listing of these opinions and a brief description of the opinions follow in Appendix B, below.

Education and Presentations

Sixty-three (63) educational and training presentations were held for various groups over the past year. A full listing of these presentations follows in Appendix A, below.

Access Handbook and other Educational Materials

The Public Access Handbook that is a collaborative effort between the Office and the Indiana Attorney General was revised effective June 2000. The most current version of the booklet is posted on the Office's website, <u>www.state.in.us/pac</u>. Copies of the booklet are currently being printed and will be distributed to public officials and available for distribution to members of the public as well. We are also working on additional publications, including a handbook on public access for law enforcement agencies, which is intended to be a resource for public officials and citizens throughout the state.
