# ANNUAL REPORT OF THE PUBLIC ACCESS COUNSELOR To the Indiana General Assembly

July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007

Pursuant to Indiana Code section 5-14-4-12, this is the annual report of the activities of the Office of the Public Access Counselor (Office) for the time period covering July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007. # PART II Executive Summary

### **Public Access Counselor and Staff**

The Office of the Public Access Counselor is staffed by Karen Davis, the Public Access Counselor, and one administrative assistant. Karen Davis was appointed to fill a four-year term of office ending June 30, 2007.

### **Advisory Opinions**

From July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007, the Office issued 251 written advisory opinions. This number represents a 15% increase in the number of advisory opinions issued compared with the previous reporting period. Forty-three complaints were pending as of June 30, 2007. Under Indiana Code 5-14-5-9, advisory opinions must be issued within thirty days of receipt of a formal complaint. The deadline for priority complaints is seven days. Ind. Code 5-14-5-10; 62 IAC 1. The Office met the statutory requirement for timely issuance of advisory opinions. A detailed list of advisory opinions and a brief description of the opinions follow in Appendix B, below.

### **Education and Presentations**

The Public Access Counselor made twenty-four educational presentations in nine Indiana cities and towns over the past year. Appendix A contains a list of the presentations.

### **Handbook and Other Educational Materials**

The Public Access Handbook was most recently revised in December 2003, and it is posted on the Office's website, <a href="www.IN.gov/pac">www.IN.gov/pac</a>. The Office will need to update the statutes in the Handbook to reflect legislative changes in the access laws enacted in 2005, 2006, and 2007. The Office receives many requests for the print version of the Handbook. In order to save cost to the Office, the Office encourages persons to download the Handbook from the web for free. However, there is still strong demand for a paper Handbook, even where the requesters have access to the electronic version. The Office updated a tri-fold brochure that is available in the Agency Services Center of the Government Center South. The Counselor prepared numerous articles for presentation at Continuing Legal Education seminars in 2006-07. The Counselor also prepared slides and handouts for participants at the educational sites where the Counselor was invited.
